Illegible entries will not be processed and will be returned to the exhibitor. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry and the Trial Secretary will add a \$25.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check.

RANDOM DRAW

Due to the Random Draw Entry method, worker spaces will be held for a limited number of handlers by the trial committee. Those who wish to be considered for the workers' draw list must agree to work at least two classes per day, and help with set up and/or tear down. Those who volunteer and receive a designated spot, but do not fulfill their worker assignments during the trial will not be considered for future designated spots in Mountain States Dog Training Club Random Draw Trials.

In compliance with AKC Regulations for Agility Trials, Mountain States Dog Training Club establishes the policy that designated worker spots are allowed to handlers working 2 or fewer dogs during any day of the trial. Handlers entering/running more than 2 dogs will be placed in the Draw for entry spaces, and not considered for designated worker spots during this trial. Preference for designated worker spots will be given to those handlers entering all days of the trial, over a single days entries. \$4.00 coupon (toward future MSDTC events) will be provided for all workers per class worked.

All exhibitors supplying a legible and current email address will receive notification of entry receipt, and draw outcome after the Random Draw has been held and processed. All entry forms and payment checks that do not make the draw for the Trial will be placed on the waiting list for a spot until the closing date. Unless otherwise requested, all entries that do not make it into the Trial will be shredded after the closing date, June 2, 2018.

WAIT LIST FOR WITHDRAWN ENTRIES

After the closing date, MSDTC is offering a Wait List to fill openings created by withdrawn entries after closing. A maximum of 20 entries will be placed on the wait list. All entries including wait listed entries must be received by the Trial Secretary prior to June 2, 2018, 5:00 p.m. (MT). Any entries withdrawn prior to 5:00 PM, June 10, 2018, will be replaced by a wait list entry, a full refund will be given to withdrawn entries when wait listed entries are available to replace the pulled entry. Any wait list entry that does not move off the wait list into the trial by 5:00 PM, June 10, 2018 will receive a full refund.

OBSTACLES

Obstacles will meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of the Regulations for Agility Trials. Ring measurement 90' x 100'. The trial will be held outdoors on the sport turf.

COURSE FAMILIARIZATION & TIMING

Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, during a walk-through period held prior to the start of the class. The walk-through is restricted to handlers entered in that class only. Handlers with multiple dogs, at events with multiple rings may request to walk with a height group other than the one their dog is entered in if a conflict is imminent.

A warm-up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump, may be provided for exhibitors. The warm-up area is to be used exclusively for warming up the dog and not for training or relieving of the dog. Umbrellas are not allowed on the course during the walk thru.

Electronic timing devices may be used.

HEIGHT DIVISIONS

Effective January 1, 2010, exhibitors are no longer required to provide proof to Trial Secretaries that their dog has a valid jump height card as part of the check-in process. Furthermore, this change eliminates the need for a copy of the jump height card to be submitted with an entry form. Dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form may still compete; but they must be measured/wicketed by the **Judge of Record** PRIOR to running in their class and this measurement will be valid for that weekend of trials only. The exception to this requirement is a dog entered in the 24" or 26" height division. However, if a **Volunteer Measuring Official (VMO)** or an **Agility Field Rep** is present; **ALL** dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form must be measured at some time during the trial or cluster of trials. This does not preclude having the dog wicketed by the Judge of Record if the VMO or Rep is not available to measure the dog **before** its first run of the trial or cluster of trials. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured prior to running and failure to do so will result in the cancellation of any qualifying scores.

PLEASE do not damage any motel rooms or their surrounding areas. Your cooperation will ensure the future availability of the area motels. Failure to comply with these simple courtesies is grounds for a show committee, which can result in suspension of AKC privileges and prohibit participation in all future MSDTC events.

RV's:

The facility will not allow overnight RV parking. Daytime RV parking will be restricted due to construction around the facility. The facility will not allow RVs on the concrete parking lot near the building. RVs owners are self directed to locate an acceptable parking spot. EXHIBITOR INFORMATION

SAFETY, BEHAVIOR and LIABILITY

The safety of the dog is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. The Mountain States Dog Training Club and its agents, employees, etc., will assume no responsibilities for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children. The Mountain States Dog Training Club reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression. No one shall have any recourse or claim against the Mountain States Dog Training Club or any official thereof.

All dogs must be on leash at all times when on trial grounds except when in the designated warm-up area or competing on the course.

All regulations governing the use of this facility, and all regulations and decisions of the trial committee at this trial will be strictly enforced, including and not limited to the recorded information of this premium list.

Puppies under 4 months of age are prohibited at AKC Agility Trials.

This club does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the Official AKC entry form for this event.

ENTRY ELIGIBILITY

This trial is open to all dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number (in trials offering mixed breed entries), or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate.

Dogs with a Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number (in trials allowing mixed breed entries) must be spayed or neutered in order to compete. Wherever the word "dog" is used in these regulations it includes both sexes.

Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind or deaf shall not be eligible, and neither are bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate. Puppies under six months of age are strictly prohibited from the trial grounds.

REFUNDS

No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. No entry fee will be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of the Event Committee.

Bitches in season are not permitted to compete in AKC Agility Trials. The Club will issue a refund for the trial entries, less a \$10.00/entered day processing fee.

Chapter 1, Section 9 of the [Regulations for Agility Trials](http://images.akc.org/pdf/rulebooks/REAGIL.pdf), <http://images.akc.org/pdf/rulebooks/REAGIL.pdf>, states, "Females in season must be fully refunded if withdrawn by the Trial Secretary after closing and no later than one half hour prior to the start of the first class of the day of the trial. The club may retain a processing fee and must publish this information in the premium (no fee is paid to the American Kennel Club for females in season who are withdrawn)."

CATALOGS

A limited number of catalogs will be available for sale at the trial site for a cost of \$5.00. Running order sheets will be emailed to all exhibitors with their Final Confirmations. If you wish to use a Running Order at the trial, please print a copy for your own use.

OFFICIAL AMERICAN KENNEL CLUB AGILITY TRIAL MOVE-UP FORM

RINGSIDE

Dogs may arrive any time prior to judging. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running. All dogs not needed for further judging will be excused.

Judges are not required to wait for dogs. The Owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when it is to be judged. The Club has no responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required. Exhibitors may bring their own chairs.

PARKING

Exhibitors are governed by any rules or regulations of civil authorities and building and parking regulations. Vehicles parked contrary to regulations will be subject to towing at owner's expense.

PLEASE NOTE: A limited number of handicap spaces are available. They will be available on a first-come basis. A valid handicap plate must be on each vehicle using these spaces. THESE SPACES WILL NOT ACCOMMODATE MOTOR HOMES.

Club officials may require that vehicles or equipment be rearranged to accommodate additional vehicles. Area around vehicles MUST be kept clean at all times. All vehicles will be parked at owner's risk. Apex Field House and Mountain States Dog Training Club will not be responsible for loss by burglary, fire, or any other cause whatsoever to the vehicle or its contents.

SITE INFORMATION

Apex will allow unentered dogs, owned by exhibitors, BUT no unentered dogs will be allowed on the turf and NO dogs are allowed to walk through the lobby area. Apex is willing to do this on a trial bases. PLEASE make sure you follow these rules.

Food is not allowed on the turf. The club will have a special treat area available for dogs entering or exiting the ring. Only dogs getting ready to run are allowed on the turf.

DO NOT ALLOW YOUR DOG TO RELIEVE ITSELF ON THE FLOWERS, LANDCAPING OR ROCK AREAS ALONG THE WALK WAYS AND BUILDING SURROUNDINGS.

Due to facility regulations, overnight parking will not be permitted at this event. RVs are not allowed on the concrete parking lot near the building.

Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s). Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Event Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement. Cleaning supplies and disposal sites will be available at various locations around the show grounds.

CRATING and SEATING

Ample Crating space will be available. A clean mat or tarp is required under ALL kennels and crates. Xpens are NOT allowed. Please be courteous and do not take more space than you need. Bleacher seating is available.

Crates may be left overnight; however, the Mountain States Dog Training Club and the Apex Field House will not be responsible for any lost or damaged items left at the show site.

PLEASE CLEAN UP AFTER YOUR DOG

OFFICIAL AMERICAN KENNEL CLUB AGILITY TRIAL MOVE-UP FORM

From Chapter 1, Section 20: Move-Up entries will be accepted for dogs that have completed a title after the closing date. Email notification of move up or class change is acceptable, with return receipt verification from the secretary. Either Move Up forms or emails must be completed and delivered to the Trial Secretary prior to 6 PM on the Monday evening preceding the event. Move-up entries for Saturday or Sunday must be delivered to the Trial Secretary within 30 minutes of the conclusion of judging of the class they are moving up from. Dogs so moved up will run at the end of the running order. Move-ups can only be accepted if judging limits are not exceeded.

Entry move-up valid only if the dog was already entered in the Event indicated and only if approved by the Trial Secretary. Dogs moved up will run at the end of the class running order.

Effective February 1, 2017

Regulations for Agility Trials: Chapter 1, Section 21. Change of Entry. In addition to Move-ups as described in Chapter 1, Section 20 entries may also be changed as noted in this section. A dog which has been entered in a Novice "A" class for which it is not eligible to be entered in due to class restrictions on the dog or handler may be moved to the Novice "B" class under the following conditions:

The request for the move must be in writing and presented to the superintendent or trial secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of each trial. The request must state the reason and justification for the move from a Novice "A" class to the Novice "B" class.

After the close of entries a dog may be moved down in their class level (i.e., Master to Excellent). The request for the move to the class for which the dog is eligible must be in writing and submitted to the superintendent or trial secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of the trial.

If a VMO or Field Representative at a trial measures a dog into a height other than what they entered, the entry may be changed from Regular to Preferred or from Preferred to Regular, as long as the dog has not run any classes that day. If the dog has already run, the change may be made for the next trial day(s). The exhibitor must provide the Trial Secretary the AKC Agility Measurement Form when requesting the class change.
