This trial will be held indoors on dirt. Ring Measurement minimum of 100' x 100'.

TRIAL AND SITE HOURS:

7:00 AM to 30 min after the conclusion of judging. JUDGING TO COMMENCE not earlier than 9:00 AM

Indoor crating space is not guaranteed. Please be prepared to stack crates. The building will be available for set up on May 6, 7:00 AM, ONCE THE RING IS SET for those who help with set up. Crating areas will be provided on the arena floor. Please park in designated lots, and move from the unloading area promptly after unloading.

ROUTES TO THE TRIAL

Latigo Trails Equestrian Center, 13710 Halleluiah Trail, Elbert, CO 80908

From the North:

Take I-25 south to Monument (Exit 161). Take Hwy 105 east (away from the mountains) 4.9 miles to Hwy 83. Turn right and go 2.2 miles to Hodgen Road. Turn left and go about 8.6 miles to Meridian Rd (second blinking light). Turn right and go 4 miles to Latigo Blvd. Turn left and go 1.1 miles to the second Halleluiah Trail. Turn left and go to the Latigo Trails Heritage Centre on your right (less than 0.1 miles).

From the South:

Take I-25 to Woodmen (Exit 149) in Colorado Springs. Go east (away from the mountains) on Woodmen 11.2 miles to Meridian Rd. Turn left and go 5 miles to Latigo Blvd. Turn right and go 1.1 miles to the second Halleluiah Trail. Turn left and go to the Latigo Trails Heritage Centre on your right (less than 0.1 miles).

*****PLEASE NOTE: If traveling to Colorado Springs or the trial site on I-70 West, there is a short cut that will reduce travel time by over 100 miles. Take US 24 West at Limon, CO. If snowing, check road conditions on www.cotrip.org*****

MOVE UPS AND CLASS CHANGES

From Chapter 1, Section 20: Move-Up entries will be accepted for dogs that have completed a title after the closing date. Email notification of move up or class change is acceptable, with return receipt verification from the secretary. Either Move Up forms or emails must be completed and delivered to the Trial Secretary prior to 6 PM on the Monday evening preceding the event. Move-up entries for Sunday must be delivered to the Trial Secretary within 30 minutes of the conclusion of judging of the class they are moving up from. Dogs so moved up will run at the end of the running order. Move-ups can only be accepted if judging limits are not exceeded.

Entry move-up valid only if the dog was already entered in the Event indicated and only if approved by the Trial Secretary.

Effective February 1, 2017

Regulations for Agility Trials: Chapter 1, Section 21. Change of Entry. In addition to Move-ups as described in Chapter 1, Section 20 entries may also be changed as noted in this section. A dog which has been entered in a Novice "A" class for which it is not eligible to be entered in due to class restrictions on the dog or handler may be moved to the Novice "B" class under the following conditions:

The request for the move must be in writing and presented to the superintendent or trial secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of each trial. The request must state the reason and justification for the move from a Novice "A" class to the Novice "B" class.

After the close of entries a dog may be moved down in their class level (i.e., Master to Excellent). The request for the move to the class for which the dog is eligible must be in writing and submitted to the superintendent or trial secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of the trial.

If a VMO or Field Representative at a trial measures a dog into a height other than what they entered, the entry may be changed from Regular to Preferred or from Preferred to Regular, as long as the dog has not run any classes that day. If the dog has already run, the change may be made for the next trial day(s). The exhibitor must provide the Trial Secretary the AKC Agility Measurement Form when requesting the class change.

REGARDING THE TRIAL and AKC MEASUREMENTS...

All exhibitors must check in before judging of your first class on the first day you are entered. Arm bands will be available by self-check in for all dogs/handlers who marked their entry form as having a Permanent or Temporary AKC Height. All dogs competing in agility must have a valid AKC Official Jump Height Card or form. If the dog does not have a valid Jump Height Card or form it must be measured by a VMO, AKC Field Representative or by the judge(s) of record before it runs. There will not be any VMO officials in attendance for this event.

Dogs not required for further judging will be excused. Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring when it is their turn to run. Exhibitors are required to wear the provided armbands.

Judges are not required to wait for dogs. They will adhere, as closely as possible, to the judging schedule. The owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when it is to be judged. The trial giving club and the trial secretary have no obligation or responsibility for providing service, through a public address system, or stewards, or runners, for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are to be at ring side when required.
