Due to the Random Draw Entry method, worker spaces will be held for a limited number of handlers by the trial committee. Those who wish to be considered for the workers' draw list must agree to work ½ day or more each day of the trial they have entered. Those who volunteer and receive a designated spot, but do not fulfill their worker assignments during the trial will not be considered for future designated spots in Longs Peak Dog Training Club Random Draw Trials.

Guaranteed Workers must work two classes per day they are entered OR stay for tear down on Sunday after the trial. Tear down workers will receive two worker coupons. Contact Ruth Thompson at ruthth@kraftykees.com to be considered for a Guaranteed Worker spot.

All exhibitors supplying a legible and current email address will receive notification of entry receipt, and draw outcome after the Random Draw has been held and processed. All entry forms and payment checks that do not make the draw for the Trial will be placed on the waiting list for a spot until the closing date. Unless otherwise requested, all entries that do not make it into the Trial will be shredded after the closing date, October 3, 2018.

WAIT LIST FOR WITHDRAWN ENTRIES

After the closing date, LPDTC is offering a Wait List to fill openings created by withdrawn entries after closing. A maximum of 20 entries will be placed on the wait list. All entries including wait listed entries must be received by the Trial Secretary prior to **Wednesday, October 3, 2018, 6:00 p.m.** (MT). Any entries withdrawn prior to 6:00 PM, October 14, 2018, will be replaced by a wait list entry, a full refund will be given to withdrawn entries when wait listed entries are available to replace the pulled entry. Any wait list entry that does not move off the wait list into the trial by 6:00 PM, October 14, 2018 will receive a full refund.

LPDTC AWARDS

Placement Ribbons will be awarded for the first through fourth place in each height division of each class for Standard Agility Classes and Jumpers with Weaves classes.

Dogs earning MACH1 or PACH1 will receive a personalized Rosette from LPDTC
Owners must fill out dog's information accurately at the Secretary's Office/Table.

Delivery of personalized rosettes will be arranged after completion.

Any dog receiving a MACH or PACH that is beyond their first title will receive a non-personalized MACH/PACH Rosette.

This rosette must be claimed the day of the trial.

All prizes must be claimed the day of the trial, except as noted above for MACH1/PACH1. None will be mailed.

HEIGHT DIVISIONS

Effective January 1, 2010, exhibitors are no longer required to provide proof to Trial Secretaries that their dog has a valid jump height card as part of the check-in process. Furthermore, this change eliminates the need for a copy of the jump height card to be submitted with an entry form. Dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form may still compete; but they must be measured/wicketed by the **Judge of Record** PRIOR to running in their class and this measurement will be valid for that weekend of trials only. The exception to this requirement is a dog entered in the 24" or 26" height division. However, if a **Volunteer Measuring Official (VMO)** or an **Agility Field Rep** is present; **ALL** dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form must be measured at some time during the trial or cluster of trials. This does not preclude having the dog wicketed by the Judge of Record if the VMO or Rep is not available to measure the dog **before** its first run of the trial or cluster of trials. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured prior to running and failure to do so will result in the cancellation of any qualifying scores.

If a VMO or Field Representative at a trial measures a dog into a height other than what they entered, the entry may be changed from Regular to Preferred or from Preferred to Regular, as long as the dog has not run any classes that day. If the dog has already run, the change may be made for the next trial day(s). The exhibitor must provide the Trial Secretary the AKC Agility Measurement Form when requesting the class change.

OBSTACLES

Obstacles will meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of the Regulations for Agility Trials. This trial will be held indoors, on a soccer turf ring minimum 125' x 85'.

COURSE FAMILIARIZATION & TIMING

Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, during a walk-through period held prior to the start of the class. The walk-through is restricted to handlers entered in that class only. Handlers with multiple dogs, at events with multiple rings may request to walk with a height group other than the one their dog is entered in if a conflict is imminent.

A warm-up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump, may be provided for exhibitors. The warm-up area is to be used exclusively for warming up the dog and not for training or relieving of the dog.

Electronic timing devices may be used.

ROUTES TO THE TRIAL

From Denver:

Take I-25 North toward Fort Collins. Take the Windsor Exit (Exit 262) to Hwy 392, also known as Carpenter Road. Turn right and go east on Hwy 392 about 0.4 miles to County Road 5, also known as Fairgrounds Rd. It is a stoplight street. Turn right and go south on County Road 5/Fairgrounds Rd about 0.4 miles. The first building you see to the east is the Rural Electric Assoc'n Bldg. The 2nd building you will see on the east is Arena Sports. It is a long, white barrack-like building, with green awnings over pretend windows. Turn left onto the service road at the south end of the building. Go to the parking lots located to the east of Arena. **(Mapquest gives incorrect directions, if you are planning on using Mapquest for your driving needs).**



EXHIBITOR INFORMATION

SAFETY, BEHAVIOR and LIABILITY

The safety of the dog is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. The Longs Peak Dog Training Club and its agents, employees, etc., will assume no responsibilities for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children. The Longs Peak Dog Training Club reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression. No one shall have any recourse or claim against the Longs Peak Dog Training Club, Arena Sports, or any official thereof.

All dogs must be on leash at all times when on trial grounds except when in the designated warm-up area or competing on the course.

All regulations governing the use of this facility, and all regulations and decisions of the trial committee at this trial will be strictly enforced, including and not limited to the recorded information of this premium list.

Puppies under 4 months of age are prohibited at AKC Agility Trials.

This club does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the Official AKC entry form for this event.

ENTRY ELIGIBILITY

This trial is open to all dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number (in trials offering mixed breed entries), or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate.

Dogs with a Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number (in trials allowing mixed breed entries) must be spayed or neutered in order to compete. Wherever the word "dog" is used in these regulations it includes both sexes.

Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind shall not be eligible, and neither are bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate.

REFUNDS

No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. No entry fee will be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of the Trial Committee.

Bitches in season are not permitted to compete in AKC Agility Trials. Chapter 1, Section 9 of the [Regulations for Agility Trials](http://images.akc.org/pdf/rulebooks/REAGIL.pdf), <http://images.akc.org/pdf/rulebooks/REAGIL.pdf>, states, "Females in season must be fully refunded if withdrawn by the Trial Secretary after closing and no later than one half hour prior to the start of the first class of the day of the trial. The club may retain a processing fee and must publish this information in the premium (no fee is paid to the American Kennel Club for females in season who are withdrawn). A \$10.00/ entered day processing fee will be withheld for entries withdrawn due to a bitch being reported in season."

WORKERS

A link for self-sign up will be available on the Judging Program after the trial closing. Guaranteed Workers must work two classes per day they are entered OR stay for tear down on Sunday after the trial. Tear down workers will receive two worker coupons. Contact Ruth Thompson at ruthth@krafthykees.com to be considered for a Guaranteed Worker spot.

CRATING and SEATING

Crating will be restricted to outside the ring area. There will be crating area available at the show grounds, but crating space is not guaranteed. The Show Site Committee reserves the right to alter crating arrangements for space purposes. Exhibitors are responsible for the conditions in and around their own crate. No dogs will be permitted to stay overnight at the show site.

Please be prepared to stack crates.

RINGSIDE

Dogs may arrive any time prior to judging. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running. All dogs not needed for further judging will be excused.

Judges are not required to wait for dogs. The Owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when it is to be judged. The Club has no responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required. Exhibitors may bring their own chairs.

PARKING

Exhibitors are governed by any rules or regulations of civil authorities and building and parking regulations. Vehicles parked contrary to regulations will be subject to towing at owner's expense. PLEASE NOTE: A limited number of handicap spaces are available. They will be available on a first-come basis. A valid handicap plate must be on each vehicle using these spaces. THESE SPACES WILL NOT ACCOMMODATE MOTOR HOMES.

Club officials may require that vehicles or equipment be rearranged to accommodate additional vehicles. Area around vehicles MUST be kept clean at all times. All vehicles will be parked at owner's risk. Arena Sports and Longs Peak Dog Training Club will not be responsible for loss by burglary, fire, or any other cause whatsoever to the vehicle or its contents.

PLEASE CLEAN UP AFTER YOUR DOG

OFFICIAL AMERICAN KENNEL CLUB AGILITY TRIAL MOVE-UP FORM

From Chapter 1, Section 20: Move-Up entries will be accepted for dogs that have completed a title after the closing date. Email notification of move up or class change is acceptable, with return receipt verification from the secretary. Either Move Up forms or emails must be completed and delivered to the Trial Secretary prior to 6 PM on the Monday evening preceding the event. Move-up entries for Saturday or Sunday must be delivered to the Trial Secretary within 30 minutes of the conclusion of judging of the class they are moving up from. Dogs so moved up will run at the end of the running order. Move-ups can only be accepted if judging limits are not exceeded.

Entry move-up valid only if the dog was already entered in the Event indicated and only if approved by the Trial Secretary. Dogs moved up will run at the end of the class running order.

Effective February 1, 2017

Regulations for Agility Trials: Chapter 1, Section 21. Change of Entry. In addition to Move-ups as described in Chapter 1, Section 20 entries may also be changed as noted in this section. A dog which has been entered in a Novice "A" class for which it is not eligible to be entered in due to class restrictions on the dog or handler may be moved to the Novice "B" class under the following conditions:

The request for the move must be in writing and presented to the superintendent or trial secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of each trial. The request must state the reason and justification for the move from a Novice "A" class to the Novice "B" class.

After the close of entries a dog may be moved down in their class level (i.e., Master to Excellent). The request for the move to the class for which the dog is eligible must be in writing and submitted to the superintendent or trial secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of the trial.

INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers whose dogs measure into the 8" through 20" regular jump height divisions may opt to enter in a higher or 24-choice height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs who measure into the 24" regular jump height division may not enter 24-choice. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the AKC Canine Partners ProgramSM may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler Number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner?
