BUILDING USE, AVAILABILITY & CRATING

Adams Atkinson Arena

735 S. Overland Trail, Fort Collins, CO 80521

This trial will be held indoors on dirt. One ring measurement minimum 135' x 75'

We would love to have your help. Set up will be Friday evening September 13th beginning at 6 pm. People helping with setup may arrange their crate space after setup is finished. Others may set up during trial hours."

No food service will be available on-site. There are numerous cafes, restaurants, and fast food places east of Overland Rd - many on Elizabeth St.

There is ample space to walk your dogs around the complex however **DOGS MUST BE ON LEASH AT ALL TIMES** except while warming up or during their run in the ring. Facility management is especially sensitive to this to protect the security of valuable horses boarded at the complex. Any breach of this rule will get all dog events kicked out of CSU properties.

Trial hours are 8:00 AM – 30 minutes after the conclusion of judging, daily.

Crating will be inside 12'x12' stalls with rubber-padded floors. There are 34 stalls available for our use along both sides of the arena (numbers 16 and 35 are reserved for facility staff use). X-pens are allowed.

There is additional crating space on the west end of the arena in front of the lockers. The show site committee reserves the right to alter the crating arrangements for space purposes.

Construction is being done on the Bill Pickett arena in the complex. Please respect all barriers in the area. Dogs are not allowed on the grass near the Bill Pickett arena.

Horses are boarded in the complex. Keep dogs clear of horses and don't let them interact.

EMERGENCY INFORMATION

12 minutes from trial site Go south on Overland Trail for 1.6 miles. Turn left onto Drake road. Travel east on Drake for 2.7 miles. Turn into CSU Teaching hospital on the left and follow signs to Emergency/Critical care. Call ahead to alert staff of your arrival.

PARKING

Park in the tree-lined lot to the east of the arena. **NO PARKING IN THE AREA IMMEDIATELY IN FRONT OF THE ARENA THAT IS BORDERED BY LOW WOODEN BARRIERS.** This is requested by the facility management to keep arena access clear for tractors and staff maintenance vehicles. You may drive up to the overhead doors to unload/load but must move to the tree-lined parking area afterward. There are several spaces available between the overhead doors for legally documented 'Handicapped' vehicles.

ROUTES TO THE TRIAL

From Interstate 25:

- Traveling either from the north or south, exit west off of I-25 to Prospect Road (exit 268)
- Travel west on Prospect Road approximately 7 miles to Overland Trail
- Turn right (north) onto Overland Trail
- Travel north on Overland Trail for less than a mile and the B.W. Pickett Equine Center will be on your left.
- Turn into the parking lot and park in the tree-lined parking lot to the west end of the complex. Adams-Atkinson Arena is directly in front of this lot to the west.

MOVE-UPS

From Chapter 1, Section 20: Move-Up entries will be accepted for dogs that have completed a title after the closing date. Email notification of move up or class change is acceptable, with return receipt verification from the secretary. Either Move Up forms or emails must be completed and delivered to the Trial Secretary prior to 6 PM on the Monday evening preceding the event. Move-up entries for Saturday or Sunday must be delivered to the Trial Secretary within 30 minutes of the conclusion of judging of the class they are moving up from. Dogs so moved up will run at the end of the running order. Move-ups can only be accepted if judging limits are not exceeded.

Entry move-up valid only if the dog was already entered in the Event indicated and only if approved by the Trial Secretary. Dogs moved up will run at the end of the class running order.

Effective February 1, 2017

Regulations for Agility Trials: Chapter 1, Section 21. Change of Entry. In addition to Move-ups as described in Chapter 1, Section 20 entries may also be changed as noted in this section. A dog which has been entered in a Novice "A" class for which it is not eligible to be entered in due to class restrictions on the dog or handler may be moved to the Novice "B" class under the following conditions:

The request for the move must be in writing and presented to the superintendent or trial secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of each trial. The request must state the reason and justification for the move from a Novice "A" class to the Novice "B" class.

After the close of entries a dog may be moved down in their class level (i.e., Master to Excellent). The request for the move to the class for which the dog is eligible must be in writing and submitted to the superintendent or trial secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of the trial.

WAIT LIST FOR WITHDRAWN ENTRIES

There are NO wait listed dogs for this event.

REGARDING THE TRIAL and AKC MEASUREMENTS...

This Trial is held under American Kennel Club Rules and Regulations.

All exhibitors must check in before judging of your first class on the first day you are entered. All dogs competing in agility must have a valid AKC Official Jump Height Card or form. If the dog does not have a valid Jump Height Card or form it must be measured by a VMO, AKC Field Representative or by the judge(s) of record before it runs. There will be a scheduled VMO for this trial! Armband stickers will not be used for this trial.

All ring conflicts will be handled as fairly as possible. Please let ring stewards know of any possible conflicts so that arrangements can be made for the necessary running order changes. The Standard Ring takes precedence for running. Please try to make changes to the running order in the Jumpers Ring to alleviate conflicts, when possible.
