BUILDING AVAILABILITY & CRATING

Indoor Soccer Arena at Schaefer Athletic Complex

3608 S Kipling Pkwy, Denver, CO 80235 This trial will be held indoors on artificial turf. Ring Measurements: minimum 100' x 100'
Judging to will begin 7:300 AM each day. Trial site hours 6:30 AM- 30 minutes after the conclusion of judging each day.

CHECK-IN EACH DAY BEGINNING AT 6:30 AM, and throughout the trial.

*****IMPORTANT INFORMATION REGARDING THIS SITE*****

Please exercise your dog(s) often and away from the building.

The facility requests water proof tarps under crates.

The facility has relaxed its restrictions on food and drinks on the field. Please be courteous to ensure the restrictions don't return for future trials.

CRATING and SEATING

Crating areas will be available at the show grounds but space is not guaranteed. Exhibitors will be required to lay a WATERPROOF tarp or mat under their crating space to minimize spills, food particles, and dog hair getting into the turf. If these conditions are not met, or if a set up is taking space from other competitor's ability to set up, the Show Site Committee reserves the right to alter crating arrangements for space, safety or site requirements. Seating is allowed on the field. Exhibitors are responsible for the conditions in and around their space. No dogs will be permitted to stay overnight at the show site. X-pens allowed for well-behaved dogs only. Dogs that bark excessively or that exhibit any aggressive behavior, such as snarling or lunging at other dogs or people, must be crated.

FOOD IN THE ARENA

Most food, beverages, and dog treats will be allowed in the crating area, which must be covered by a WATERPROOF tarp or mat. Take extra care to clean up spills or food particles as these attract insects and vermin into the arena. No sunflower seeds or gum permitted. Spitting is expressly forbidden and will incur a \$100 fine issued by Foothills Parks & Recreation District managers. The facility also forbids gum, pistachio nuts, and sunflower seeds anywhere in the building.

NO food vendor will be on site. Several food establishments are nearby.

BUILDING AVAILABILITY

The Trial site will be available for setup is at 4:00 – 6:00 pm on Friday, May 26, for those exhibitors who help with the ring set up. If you help set up, you may lay down a mat, but no crating will be allowed until the ring and trial needs are set up. The Trial Site will be available May 27-29, 2023 at 6:00 AM. Please park in designated lots, and move from the unloading area promptly after unloading. It is requested that you have your dog urinate away from the building.

ROUTES TO THE TRIAL

From the intersection of HWY285/Hampden and Kipling, go south. Take the first left on the south side of the ball fields. Building is at the top of the hill.

MOVE UPS AND CLASS CHANGES

From Chapter 1, Section 20: Move-Up entries will be accepted for dogs that have completed a title after the closing date May 11, 2016. Email notification of move up or class change is acceptable, with return receipt verification from the secretary. Either Move Up forms or emails must be completed and delivered to the Trial Secretary prior to 6 PM, May 23, 2016. Move-up entries for Sunday or Monday must be delivered to the Trial Secretary within 30 minutes of the conclusion of judging of the class they are moving up from. Dogs so moved up will run at the end of the running order. Move-ups can only be accepted if judging limits are not exceeded.

IMPORTANT EXHIBITOR INFORMATION...

All exhibitors must check in before judging of your first class on the first day you are entered.

All dogs competing in agility must have a valid AKC Official Jump Height Card or form. If the dog does not have a valid Jump Height Card or form it must be measured by a VMO, AKC Field Representative or by the judge(s) of record before it runs. There will be VMOs present at this trial.
