BUILDING AVAILABILITY & CRATING

Douglas County Fairgrounds, Indoor Arena

This trial will be held indoors, in two dirt rings, run concurrently.
Ring Measurements Minimum 95' x 95'each
Trial site hours: 7:00 a.m. – 30 min. following the conclusion of judging, daily. Judging to begin 8:00 a.m. each day

DO NOT ALLOW DOGS TO URINATE ON THE BUILDING OR TRASH CANS.

Specific, well indicated containers will be provided for solid dog waste, please use these containers and refrain from putting dog waste in regular or recycle trash cans.

Setup will start at 3:00, Thursday afternoon, and we do welcome your help! Those helping with set up may place a mat upon arrival. Crates may be set up once the site is set up and the all clear is given. General crating will be available during trial hours.

PARKING!! IMPORTANT!! On the south-ish end of the building, (the side where RVs are parked), cones will be placed to mark the parking for the rows closest to the building. DO NOT PARK OUTSIDE OF THE CONES. LARGE fire engines and other rescue equipment MUST be able to easily access the building and pull through. This close in parking area will be more limited than it has been in the past. The pull through area may be still be used for loading and unloading. Castle Rock Fire Department is working harder to ensure our safety and may be stopping by to ensure we are operating with a safe site plan. While there will be less close in parking there IS ample parking available, just a bit further! Thirty feet of clearance from ALL parts of the building to vehicles is REQUIRED. PDAC thanks everyone for cooperating on this important safety aspect.

IMPORTANT!! Respiratory illness. Colorado and much of the country is seeing a canine respiratory illness which for some dogs has resulted in very serious complications and some fatalities.

PLEASE:

- 1. Keep your dogs on a short leash. Do not allow your dogs to have contact with dogs outside of your/their family. Keep your dogs behind you going in and out of doors.
- 2. Cover the front of your crate. Keep your dogs noses away from other dog's crates.
- 3. Do not leave bowls out side of your crate on the ground for others to sniff/lick.
- 4. IF YOUR DOG IS ILL OR A DOG IN YOUR FAMILY IS ILL, PLEASE STAY HOME.

Indoor crating space is not guaranteed. Please be prepared to stack crates. Crating areas will be provided on the arena floor. No crating allowed in bleachers, bleacher area, or walkways. No chairs will be allowed in the crating areas. There is ample bleacher seating available. Please park in designated lots, and move from the unloading area promptly after unloading.

NO DOGS MAY BE LEFT IN THE BUILDING OVERNIGHT

MOVE UPS

It is the option of the club to allow day-to-day move-ups. Exhibitors should refer to a club's premium list to verify the club's policy for moving a dog up. If offered, dogs shall be moved up to a higher class at the request of the owner, as a result of the dog qualifying for an agility title.

From Chapter 1, Section 20: Move-Up entries will be accepted for dogs that have completed a title after the closing date. Email notification of move up or class change is acceptable, with return receipt verification from the secretary. Either Move Up forms or emails must be completed and delivered to the Trial Secretary prior to 6 PM on the Monday evening preceding the event. Move-up entries for Saturday or Sunday must be delivered to the Trial Secretary within 30 minutes of the conclusion of judging of the class they are moving up from. Dogs so moved up will run at the end of the running order. Move-ups can only be accepted if judging limits are not exceeded.

Entry move-up valid only if the dog was already entered in the Event indicated and only if approved by the Trial Secretary. Dogs moved up will run at the end of the class running order.

WAIT LIST FOR WITHDRAWN ENTRIES

There are no wait listed entries, so no after closing date pulls are available.

CONFLICTS

Some ring conflicts are unavoidable and as is customary, please indicate with a "C" next to your dog's name/number on the gate sheets. Judges will determine which ring takes precedence and that will be announced. Ring conflicts must be handled at ringside with the approval and consent of the gate steward and judge for that ring. In addition, should an entire class conflict, there could be a 'hold' on one ring while the affected group completes the other ring. PDAC thanks all exhibitors for their patience. Please attempt to walk your course during a scheduled time period. If you are running in a ring during your walk through, please walk with an earlier group (if possible) and run with that group.

All exhibitors must check in before judging of your first class on the first day you are entered. All dogs competing in agility must have a valid AKC Official Jump Height Card or form. If the dog does not have a valid Jump Height Card or form it must be measured by a VMO, AKC Field Representative or by the judge(s) of record before it runs. There will be VMOs present at this trial.
