**TRIAL AND SITE HOURS SATURDAY and SUNDAY:** The trial site opens at 6:00 am each day. Show Hours until 30 minutes after the conclusion of judging, daily. JUDGING TO COMMENCE NOT EARLIER THAN 7:30 AM EACH DAY

**TRIAL AND SITE REGULATIONS, AVAILABILITY, MAPS & CRATING**

**Paper Gate sheets will be used for check in and running. Maps will be posted at [www.lookoutk9trials.com](http://www.lookoutk9trials.com) the morning of each days event. Posted copies will also be available at the trial.**

Important information regarding dogs in the APEX Field House:

- The Facility Management has asked us to keep dogs out of the lobby area. Many groups are using the building and the staff is concerned about the dogs going through the lobby area with all the children present.
- Human food is not allowed on the turf. The club will have a special treat area available for dogs entering or exiting the ring. Only dogs getting ready to run are allowed on the turf.
- DO NOT ALLOW YOUR DOG TO RELIEVE ITSELF ON THE FLOWERS, LANDSCAPING OR ROCK AREAS ALONG THE WALK WAYS AND BUILDING SURROUNDINGS.

You can make it easier to hold future dog events at this facility by adhering to the following site requirements:

- Only dogs that are getting ready to run, that are running, or that just ran are allowed on the turf. Unentered dogs are not allowed on the turf.
- To minimize traffic on the turf and to give dogs warming up and cooling down as much room as possible, we are asking you to leave your personal chair outside the turf area unless you are working in the ring and prefer your own chair. We will have some chairs available for exhibitors to use while they are preparing for their runs.

Crating:

- Please bring clean mats to put under your crates. The cleaner we leave the facility, the easier it will be for clubs to schedule events here. It also helps reduce the impact of cleaning expenses on entry fees.
- Please be courteous with your set up. The aisle ways are narrow, and everyone should make an attempt to allow as much space for dogs and handlers to move about as possible. There is ample space available for crates and chairs, but not for extras like tables and excessive storage. Please remember EVERYONE has to take their dogs out the same doors, and leaving extra space near those doors is essential for a safe and enjoyable event. The trial committee reserves the right to rearrange set ups if necessary to accommodate all participants.

Trial set up:

- You may bring your tarp in and place it in an area, but no crates or other trial gear are allowed in the building until set up is completed on Saturday morning. You may not save a spot for a friend. We are trying to reward the people who come early to set up, your friend should join us.
- Set up starts at 6 am on Saturday. We would greatly appreciate assistance with set up Saturday morning. So that we may prepare for the trial as quickly as possible, no crates, or other trial gear are allowed in the building until set up is complete.
- Workers who stay for clean-up will be greatly appreciated on Sunday afternoon.
- No Friday set up.

## USEFUL INFORMATION ABOUT THE APEX FIELD HOUSE:

- The facility contains two full-sized turf arenas connected by a lobby. We will be using the south field. As you stand in the parking lot looking at the lobby, our field will be the one on the right. The door on the southwest corner of the building will provide the easiest access to the field and it will be open during trial hours.
- The arena is climate controlled, with built in radiant heat and evaporative cooling as needed.
- The parking lot is close to the arena, so crating out of the car is a viable option depending on weather conditions. The trees in the parking lot are not mature enough to provide useful shade.
- Some bleacher seating for spectators is available outside the field. Tables and chairs are also available in the lobby.
- Grassy parks and athletic fields surround the facility. Dogs are allowed in the parks. Dogs must be leashed.
- The areas around the building and parking lot that are landscaped with rocks and mulch are off-limits to dogs. Grassy areas are fine.
- Soccer leagues will use the north indoor field during trial hours on Saturday and Sunday. Expect children in the building.
- **Soccer leagues are scheduled on our field at 5:00 pm on Sunday. Your assistance with clean up on Sunday would be appreciated.**

From the intersection of I-70 and Kipling, go north. Turn left on 58th Ave, and then take the next left on Oak Street. The Apex Field House is on the left.

## AFTER CLOSING WAIT LIST

After the closing date, GDSCWTC is offering a Wait List to fill openings created by withdrawn entries after closing. A maximum of 10 entries (runs/day) will be placed on the wait list. All entries including wait listed entries must be received by the Trial Secretary prior to July 20, 2024 5:00 p.m. (MT). Any entries withdrawn prior to 6:00 PM, July 28, 2024, will be replaced by a wait list entry, a full refund will be given to withdrawn entries when wait listed entries are available to replace the pulled entry. Any wait list entry that does not move off the wait list into the trial by 5:00 PM, July 28, 2024 will receive a full refund.

## MOVE UPS AND CLASS CHANGES

**From Chapter 1, Section 20:** Move-Up entries will be accepted for dogs that have completed a title after the closing date. Email notification of move up or class change is acceptable, with return receipt verification from the secretary. Either Move Up forms or emails must be completed and delivered to the Trial Secretary prior to 6 PM on the Monday evening preceding the event. Move-up entries for Sunday must be delivered to the Trial Secretary within 30 minutes of the conclusion of judging of the class they are moving up from. Dogs so moved up will run at the end of the running order. Move-ups can only be accepted if judging limits are not exceeded.

Entry move-up valid only if the dog was already entered in the Event indicated and only if approved by the Trial Secretary. Dogs moved up will run at the end of the class running order.

**Effective February 1, 2017**

**Regulations for Agility Trials: Chapter 1, Section 21. Change of Entry.** In addition to Move-ups as described in Chapter 1, Section 20 entries may also be changed as noted in this section. A dog which has been entered in a Novice "A" class for which it is not eligible to be entered in due to class restrictions on the dog or handler may be moved to the Novice "B" class under the following conditions:

The request for the move must be in writing and presented to the superintendent or trial secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of each trial. The request must state the reason and justification for the move from a Novice "A" class to the Novice "B" class.

After the close of entries a dog may be moved down in their class level (i.e., Master to Excellent). The request for the move to the class for which the dog is eligible must be in writing and submitted to the superintendent or trial secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of the trial.

If a VMO or Field Representative at a trial measures a dog into a height other than what they entered, the entry may be changed from Regular to Preferred or from Preferred to Regular, as long as the dog has not run any classes that day. If the dog has already run, the change may be made for the next trial day(s). The exhibitor must provide the Trial Secretary the AKC Agility Measurement Form when requesting the class change.

If your dog needs to be measured, there will be VMOs present at this trial.

## GDSCWTC Schedule of Events

Classes will be judged in the following order. Breaks may be called at the judge's discretion. Preliminary running order contingent on move-up entries not yet received and wait listed entry changes not yet received. (\*\*Judges reserve the right to reorganize the schedule below to accommodate the needs of the trial\*\*) "B" class dogs will run prior to "A" class dogs in the Novice classes, within height classifications, except where indicated otherwise. A warm-up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump, shall be provided for all exhibitors.
