**BUILDING AVAILABILITY & CRATING**

This trial will be held indoors, on a dirt ring. Ring Measurement Minimum 100' x 90'

Trial site hours: 7:00 a.m. – 30 min. following the conclusion of judging, daily.

Judging to begin 8:30 a.m. Friday, 8:00 a.m. on Saturday & Sunday

**We'd love your help in setting up on Friday AM beginning at 7:00 AM.  
You will be able to put your matt down but we request you then help set up**

Indoor crating space is not guaranteed. Please be prepared to stack crates. Limited crating areas will be provided on the arena floor. No crating allowed in bleachers, bleacher area, or walkways. There is ample bleacher seating available. Please park in designated lots, and move from the unloading area promptly after unloading. X-pens are allowed for 3 or more dogs.

**NO DOGS MAY BE LEFT IN THE BUILDING OVERNIGHT**

**PLEASE DO NOT ALLOW DOGS TO URINATE ON THE BUILDING OR TRASH CANS.**

**DIRECTIONS FROM TRIAL SITE:** Get on I-70 E in West Pleasant View from W 6th Ave Frontage Rd, Denver West Colorado Mills Blvd and W Colfax Ave, 6 min (1.4 mi) Follow I-70 E to W 44th Ave in Wheat Ridge. Take exit 266 from I-70 E -4 min (4.3 mi) Turn left onto W 44th Ave 3 min (1.2 mi)

**ROUTES TO THE TRIAL**

**From the East (Downtown Denver, Aurora, etc.):**

Travel west on 6th Avenue to the Indiana Street/Denver West/Colorado Mills exit. Turn left (south) onto Indiana Street and travel approximately one block. Turn right (west) onto the 6th Avenue Frontage Road and travel approximately two blocks. The main entrance to the Fairgrounds will be on your left. Follow the signage posted at the main entrance to your desired destination.

**From the South (Castle Rock, Colorado Springs, etc.):**

Travel north on I-25 to West 6th Avenue. Exit I-25 at Exit 209B and travel west on West 6th Avenue approximately eight miles. Exit off West 6th Avenue at the Indiana Street/Denver West/Colorado Mills exit. Turn left (south) onto Indiana Street and travel approximately one block. Turn right (west) onto the 6th Avenue Frontage Road and travel approximately two blocks. The main entrance to the Fairgrounds will be on your left. Follow the signage posted at the main entrance to your desired destination.

**From the West (Evergreen, Idaho Springs, etc.):**

Travel east on I-70 to West 6th Avenue (Exit 261). Travel approximately one-half mile to the Indiana Street/Denver West/Colorado Mills exit. Turn right (south) onto Indiana Street and travel approximately one block. Turn right (west) onto the 6th Avenue Frontage Road and travel approximately two blocks. The main entrance to the Fairgrounds will be on your left. Follow the signage posted at the main entrance to your desired destination.

**From the North (Loveland, Fort Collins, etc.):**

Travel south on I-25 to West 6th Avenue. Exit I-25 at Exit 209B and travel west on West 6th Avenue approximately eight miles. Exit off West 6th Avenue at the Indiana Street/Denver West/Colorado Mills exit. Turn left (south) onto Indiana Street and travel approximately one block. Turn right (west) onto the 6th Avenue Frontage Road and travel approximately two blocks. The main entrance to the Fairgrounds will be on your left. Follow the signage posted at the main entrance to your desired destination.

## MOVE UPS AND CLASS CHANGES

**From Chapter 1, Section 20:** Move-Up entries will be accepted for dogs that have completed a title after the closing date. Email notification of move up or class change is acceptable, with return receipt verification from the secretary. Either Move Up forms or emails must be completed and delivered to the Trial Secretary prior to 6 PM on the Monday evening preceding the event. Move-up entries for Saturday or Sunday must be delivered to the Trial Secretary within 30 minutes of the conclusion of judging of the class they are moving up from. Dogs so moved up will run at the end of the running order. Move-ups can only be accepted if judging limits are not exceeded.

Entry move-up valid only if the dog was already entered in the Event indicated and only if approved by the Trial Secretary. Dogs moved up will run at the end of the class running order.

### Effective February 1, 2017

**Regulations for Agility Trials: Chapter 1, Section 21. Change of Entry.** In addition to Move-ups as described in Chapter 1, Section 20 entries may also be changed as noted in this section. A dog which has been entered in a Novice "A" class for which it is not eligible to be entered in due to class restrictions on the dog or handler may be moved to the Novice "B" class under the following conditions:

The request for the move must be in writing and presented to the superintendent or trial secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of each trial. The request must state the reason and justification for the move from a Novice "A" class to the Novice "B" class.

After the close of entries a dog may be moved down in their class level (i.e., Master to Excellent). The request for the move to the class for which the dog is eligible must be in writing and submitted to the superintendent or trial secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of the trial.

If a VMO or Field Representative at a trial measures a dog into a height other than what they entered, the entry may be changed from Regular to Preferred or from Preferred to Regular, as long as the dog has not run any classes that day. If the dog has already run, the change may be made for the next trial day(s). The exhibitor must provide the Trial Secretary the AKC Agility Measurement Form when requesting the class change.

## WAIT LIST FOR WITHDRAWN ENTRIES

Since there are no dogs on a waiting list, there are no post-closing entry pulls or refunds.

## CONFLICTS

In a one ring trial, running order conflicts are less common. Yet, some ring conflicts are unavoidable and as is customary, please indicate with a "C" next to your dog's name/number on the gate sheets. Judges will determine which ring takes precedence and that will be announced. Ring conflicts must be handled at ringside with the approval and consent of the gate steward and judge for that ring. Please attempt to walk your course during a scheduled time period. If you are running in a different ring during your walk through, please walk with a different group and run with that group.

### REGARDING THE TRIAL and AKC MEASUREMENTS...

All exhibitors must check in before judging of your first class on the first day you are entered. All dogs competing in agility must have a valid AKC Official Jump Height Card or form. If the dog does not have a valid Jump Height Card or form it must be measured by a VMO, AKC Field Representative or by the judge(s) of record before it runs. There will be a VMO present at this trial.

Armband stickers will not be used at this trial. Exhibitors will check in on Gate Sheets at the trial.

Dogs not required for further judging will be excused. Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring when it is their turn to run.

Judges are not required to wait for dogs. They will adhere, as closely as possible, to the judging schedule. The owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when it is to be judged. The trial giving club and the trial secretary have no obligation or responsibility for providing service, through a public address system, or stewards, or runners, for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are to be at ring side when required.

### HEARTWORM CLINIC



#### **\$10 heartworm tests available at this trial!**

A heartworm testing clinic will be held on Saturday, in the area behind the restrooms at Jeffco (southeast corner). The clinic will begin at 9:30 am and continue as long as there are customers. *The testing is open-to-the-public, so there will be dogs in the area other than those in the trial.* We will direct people for the clinic to use the southeast door that leads directly to the testing area; community members coming for the testing should not interfere with the trial and we will be diligent to direct them to the proper entrance and testing area. If you haven't had heart worm test for your dogs this year, we hope you will take advantage of this clinic. The cost is \$10 per dog. Heart worm meds will also be available for purchase.

## MHACB Trial Hours & Schedule of Events

Classes will be judged in the following order. Breaks may be called at the judge's discretion. Preliminary running order contingent on move-up entries not yet received and wait listed entry changes not yet received. (\*\*Judges reserve the right to reorganize the schedule below to accommodate the needs of the trial\*\*) "B" class dogs will run prior to "A" class dogs in the Novice classes, within height classifications, except where indicated otherwise. A warm-up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump, shall be provided for all exhibitors.
