BUILDING AVAILABILITY & CRATING

Douglas County Fairgrounds, Indoor Arena

This trial will be held indoors, in two dirt rings, run concurrently.

Ring Measurements Minimum 95' x 95' each

Trial site hours: 7:00 a.m. – 30 min. following the conclusion of judging, daily. Judging to begin 8:00 a.m. each day

DO NOT ALLOW DOGS TO URINATE ON THE BUILDING OR TRASH CANS.

Specific, well indicated containers will be provided for solid dog waste, please use these containers and refrain from putting dog waste in regular or recycle trash cans.

Those helping with set up will be able to set up their crating area when the trial set up is complete.

We will start at 3:00, Thursday afternoon, and we do welcome your help! General crating will be available during trial hours. All exhibitors, vendors and guests are reminded of the fire lanes and parking restrictions at the north and south ends of the building. Thirty feet of clearance from the all parts of the building to vehicles is REQUIRED. PDAC thanks everyone for cooperating on this important safety aspect.

Indoor crating space is not guaranteed. Please be prepared to stack crates. Limited crating areas will be provided on the arena floor. No crating allowed in bleachers, bleacher area, or walkways. No chairs will be allowed in the crating areas. There is ample bleacher seating available. Please park in designated lots, and move from the unloading area promptly after unloading. X-pens are allowed for 3 or more dogs.

RV PARKING

ALL RV's MUST be pre-registered and paid in advance, including dry camping and day parking. RV's without reservations will be required to park outside the fence in Lot #1. RV's with reservations will receive confirmation and parking information prior to the event.

Cost \$15 per night w/ electric. (same charge for day use only w/ electric). No fee for dry camping-reservations and EXHAUST DIVERTERS REQUIRED due to a high fire danger in the area. Overnight RV parking will be pre-assigned on a first received basis and requires advanced payment for all nights of the event. RV's with reservations will receive confirmation and parking information prior to the event. Parking allowed after 3 pm, Thursday. No earlier hook-ups. Priority parking is given to non-RV, day use entrants to the event.

MOVE UPS

It is the option of the club to allow day-to-day move-ups. Exhibitors should refer to a club's premium list to verify the club's policy for moving a dog up. If offered, dogs shall be moved up to a higher class at the request of the owner, as a result of the dog qualifying for an agility title.

From Chapter 1, Section 20: Move-Up entries will be accepted for dogs that have completed a title after the closing date. Email notification of move up or class change is acceptable, with return receipt verification from the secretary. Either Move Up forms or emails must be completed and delivered to the Trial Secretary prior to 6 PM on the Monday evening preceding the event. Move-up entries for Saturday or Sunday must be delivered to the Trial Secretary within 30 minutes of the conclusion of judging of the class they are moving up from. Dogs so moved up will run at the end of the running order. Move-ups can only be accepted if judging limits are not exceeded.

Entry move-up valid only if the dog was already entered in the Event indicated and only if approved by the Trial Secretary. Dogs moved up will run at the end of the class running order.

Effective February 1, 2017

Regulations for Agility Trials: Chapter 1, Section 21. Change of Entry. In addition to Move-ups as described in Chapter 1, Section 20 entries may also be changed as noted in this section. A dog which has been entered in a Novice "A" class for which it is not eligible to be entered in due to class restrictions on the dog or handler may be moved to the Novice "B" class under the following conditions:

The request for the move must be in writing and presented to the superintendent or trial secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of each trial. The request must state the reason and justification for the move from a Novice "A" class to the Novice "B" class.

After the close of entries a dog may be moved down in their class level (i.e., Master to Excellent). The request for the move to the class for which the dog is eligible must be in writing and submitted to the superintendent or trial secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of the trial.

If a VMO or Field Representative at a trial measures a dog into a height other than what they entered, the entry may be changed from Regular to Preferred or from Preferred to Regular, as long as the dog has not run any classes that day. If the dog has already run, the change may be made for the next trial day(s). The exhibitor must provide the Trial Secretary the AKC Agility Measurement Form when requesting the class change.

CONFLICTS

Some ring conflicts are unavoidable and as is customary, please indicate with a "C" next to your dog's name/number on the gate sheets. Judges will determine which ring takes precedence and that will be announced. Ring conflicts must be handled at ringside with the approval and consent of the gate steward and judge for that ring. In addition, should an entire class conflict, there could be a 'hold' on one ring while the affected group completes the other ring. PDAC thanks all exhibitors for their patience. Please attempt to walk your course during a scheduled time period. If you are running in a different ring during your walk through, please walk with a different group and run with that group.

REGARDING THE TRIAL and AKC MEASUREMENTS...

All exhibitors must check in before judging of your first class on the first day you are entered. All dogs competing in agility must have a valid AKC Official Jump Height Card or form. If the dog does not have a valid Jump Height Card or form it must be measured by a VMO, AKC Field Representative or by the judge(s) of record before it runs. There will be VMOs present at this trial.

Armband stickers will not be used at this trial. Exhibitors will check in on Gate Sheets at the trial.

Dogs not required for further judging will be excused. Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring when it is their turn to run. Exhibitors are required to wear the provided armbands.

Judges are not required to wait for dogs. They will adhere, as closely as possible, to the judging schedule. The owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when it is to be judged. The trial giving club and the trial secretary have no obligation or responsibility for providing service, through a public address system, or stewards, or runners, for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are to be at ring side when required. **Complete information regarding AKC's Measurement Policy can be found at http://www.akc.org/events/agility/jump_height_card.cfm**
