Changes, additions, or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing prior to close of entries or as indicated in this document for move-ups. Those received by telephone are not acceptable. Please notify Secretary of any change of address. Unsigned entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on Official AKC Entry Forms and photocopies of entry forms without agreement and rules on the reverse side of the Official AKC Entry Form are NOT ACCEPTABLE. Illegible entries will not be processed and will be returned to the exhibitor. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry and the Trial Secretary will add a \$25.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check.

### WAIT LIST FOR WITHDRAWN ENTRIES

After the closing date, DCA is offering a Wait List to fill openings created by withdrawn entries after closing. A maximum of 25 entries will be placed on the wait list. All entries including wait listed entries must be received by the Trial Secretary prior to **April 18, 2018, 6:00 p.m.** (MT). Any entries withdrawn prior to 5:00 PM, APRIL 29, 2018, will be replaced by a wait list entry, a full refund will be given to withdrawn entries when wait listed entries are available to replace the pulled entry. Any wait list entry that does not move off the wait list into the trial by 5:00 PM, APRIL 29, 2018 will receive a full refund.

### COURSE FAMILIARIZATION & TIMING

Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, during a walk-through period held prior to the start of the class. The walk-through is restricted to handlers entered in that class only. Handlers with multiple dogs, at events with multiple rings may request to walk with a height group other than the one their dog is entered in if a conflict is imminent.

A warm-up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump, may be provided for exhibitors. The warm-up area is to be used exclusively for warming up the dog and not for training or relieving of the dog. Umbrellas are not allowed on the course during the walk thru.

**Electronic timing devices may be used.**

## OBSTACLES

Obstacles will meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of the Regulations for Agility Trials. Contacts will have rubberized surfaces. All classes will take place indoors on dirt. Ring Measurement minimum of 100' x 100'.

## HEIGHT DIVISIONS

Effective January 1, 2010, exhibitors are no longer required to provide proof to Trial Secretaries that their dog has a valid jump height card as part of the check-in process. Furthermore, this change eliminates the need for a copy of the jump height card to be submitted with an entry form. Dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form may still compete; but they must be measured/wicketed by the **Judge of Record** PRIOR to running in their class and this measurement will be valid for that weekend of trials only. The exception to this requirement is a dog entered in the 24" or 26" height division. However, if a **Volunteer Measuring Official (VMO)** or an **Agility Field Rep** is present; **ALL** dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form must be measured at some time during the trial or cluster of trials. This does not preclude having the dog wicketed by the Judge of Record if the VMO or Rep is not available to measure the dog **before** its first run of the trial or cluster of trials. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured prior to running and failure to do so will result in the cancellation of any qualifying scores.

## ROUTES TO THE TRIAL

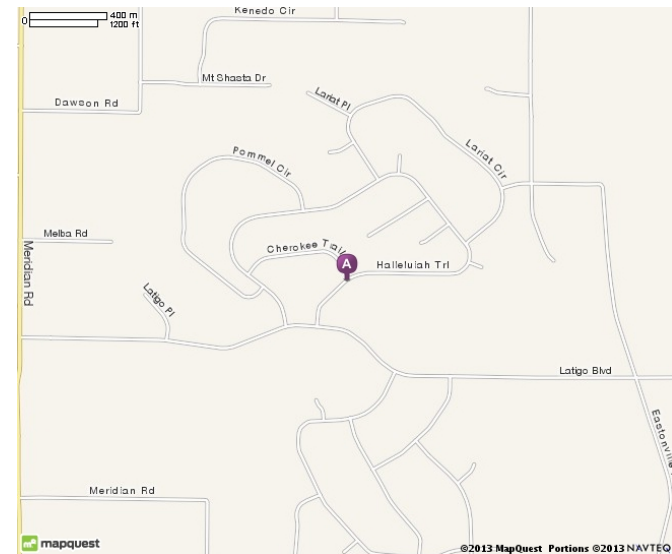
**Latigo Trails Equestrian Center, 13710 Halleluiah Trail, Elbert, CO 80908**

### From the North:

Take I-25 south to Monument (Exit 161). Take Hwy 105 east (away from the mountains) 4.9 miles to Hwy 83. Turn right and go 2.2 miles to Hodgen Road. Turn left and go about 8.6 miles to Meridian Rd (second blinking light). Turn right and go 4 miles to Latigo Blvd. Turn left and go 1.1 miles to the second Halleluiah Trail. Turn left and go to the Latigo Trails Heritage Centre on your right (less than 0.1 miles).

### From the South:

Take I-25 to Woodmen (Exit 149) in Colorado Springs. Go east (away from the mountains) on Woodmen 11.2 miles to Meridian Rd. Turn left and go 5 miles to Latigo Blvd. Turn right and go 1.1 miles to the second Halleluiah Trail. Turn left and go to the Latigo Trails Heritage Centre on your right (less than 0.1 miles).

## NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

### SAFETY, BEHAVIOR and LIABILITY

The safety of the dog is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. The show-giving club, the Show Secretary, the land-owners nor Latigo Trails Equestrian Center assume responsibilities for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children. The DALMATIAN CLUB OF AMERICA, INC reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression. No one shall have any recourse or claim against the DALMATIAN CLUB OF AMERICA, INC or any official thereof.

All dogs must be on leash at all times when on trial grounds except when in the designated warm-up area or competing on the course.

All regulations governing the use of this facility, and all regulations and decisions of the trial committee at this trial will be strictly enforced, including and not limited to the recorded information of this premium list.

Puppies under 4 months of age are prohibited at AKC Agility Trials.

**This club does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the Official AKC entry form for this event.**

### ENTRY ELIGIBILITY

**This Event is open to DALMATIANS ONLY.**

This trial is open to all Dalmatians fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP).

Dogs with a Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number must be spayed or neutered in order to compete. Wherever the word "dog" is used in these regulations it includes both sexes.

Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind shall not be eligible, and neither are bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate.

### REFUNDS

No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. No entry fee will be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of the Trial Committee, Judge or Veterinarian.

Bitches in season are not permitted to compete in Agility Trials. As such, the club will refund a portion of the paid fees per day of the entry fee paid for bitches unable to compete for this reason upon presentation of a veterinarian certificate. This certificate must be presented to the Trial Secretary prior to the start of judging on the first day of the trial or cluster of trials. A \$10.00/entered day recording fee will be withheld for entries withdrawn due to a bitch being reported in season. There will be no refund for duplicate entries.

### RINGSIDE

Dogs may arrive any time prior to judging. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running. All dogs not needed for further judging will be excused.

Judges are not required to wait for dogs. The Owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when it is to be judged. The Club has no responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required. Exhibitors may bring their own chairs and tenting for shade.

### CRATING and SEATING

Crating will be restricted to outside the ring area. There will be crating area available at the show grounds, but crating space is not guaranteed. The Show Site Committee reserves the right to alter crating arrangements for space purposes. Exhibitors are responsible for the conditions in and around their own crate. No dogs will be permitted to stay overnight at the show site.

### CATALOGS

Catalogs are available for pre-order at [www.dcanational.com](http://www.dcanational.com) and a limited number of catalogs will be available for sale at the show. Exhibitors should print their own copies and bring them to the trial if they wish to have a copy of the running order.

### ADDITIONAL NOTICES

No videotaping or photography during the events for resale is permitted without Dalmatian Club of America, Inc. approval.

Please be advised: when an exhibitor/handler brings a dog to the podium for a win/placement photo they are establishing a de facto contract with the show photographer to purchase that photo.

No baby strollers are allowed near the ring during show hours.

All AKC Rules and Regulations will be enforced by the Show Event Committee under AKC guidelines. Failure to comply with these rules will result in charges being brought before the Show Event Committee. Any event hearing, disciplinary action, rule violations, complaints, or charges will be resolved by the Dalmatian Club of America, Inc. National Specialty Event Committee. **OFFICIAL AMERICAN KENNEL CLUB AGILITY TRIAL MOVE-UP FORM**

**From Chapter 1, Section 20:** Move-Up entries will be accepted for dogs that have completed a title after the closing date. Email notification of move up or class change is acceptable, with return receipt verification from the secretary. Either Move Up forms or emails must be completed and delivered to the Trial Secretary prior to 6 PM on the Monday evening preceding the event. Move-up entries for Sunday must be delivered to the Trial Secretary within 30 minutes of the conclusion of judging of the class they are moving up from. Dogs so moved up will run at the end of the running order. Move-ups can only be accepted if judging limits are not exceeded.

Entry move-up valid only if the dog was already entered in the Event indicated and only if approved by the Trial Secretary.

**Effective February 1, 2017**

**Regulations for Agility Trials: Chapter 1, Section 21. Change of Entry.** In addition to Move-ups as described in Chapter 1, Section 20 entries may also be changed as noted in this section. A dog which has been entered in a Novice "A" class for which it is not eligible to be entered in due to class restrictions on the dog or handler may be moved to the Novice "B" class under the following conditions:

The request for the move must be in writing and presented to the superintendent or trial secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of each trial. The request must state the reason and justification for the move from a Novice "A" class to the Novice "B" class.

After the close of entries a dog may be moved down in their class level (i.e., Master to Excellent). The request for the move to the class for which the dog is eligible must be in writing and submitted to the superintendent or trial secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of the trial.

If a VMO or Field Representative at a trial measures a dog into a height other than what they entered, the entry may be changed from Regular to Preferred or from Preferred to Regular, as long as the dog has not run any classes that day. If the dog has already run, the change may be made for the next trial day(s). The exhibitor must provide the Trial Secretary the AKC Agility Measurement Form when requesting the class change.
