MOVE UPS

It is the option of the club to allow day-to-day move-ups. From Chapter 1, Section 20: Move-Up entries will be accepted for dogs that have completed a title after the closing date. Email notification of move up or class change is acceptable, with return receipt verification from the secretary. Either Move Up forms or emails must be completed and delivered to the Trial Secretary prior to 6 PM on the Monday evening preceding the event. Move-up entries for Saturday or Sunday must be delivered to the Trial Secretary within 30 minutes of the conclusion of judging of the class they are moving up from. Dogs so moved up will run at the end of the running order. Move-ups can only be accepted if judging limits are not exceeded.

Entry move-up valid only if the dog was already entered in the Event indicated and only if approved by the Trial Secretary. Dogs moved up will run at the end of the class running order.

Effective February 1, 2017

Regulations for Agility Trials: Chapter 1, Section 21. Change of Entry. In addition to Move-ups as described in Chapter 1, Section 20 entries may also be changed as noted in this section. A dog which has been entered in a Novice "A" class for which it is not eligible to be entered in due to class restrictions on the dog or handler may be moved to the Novice "B" class under the following conditions:

The request for the move must be in writing and presented to the superintendent or trial secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of each trial. The request must state the reason and justification for the move from a Novice "A" class to the Novice "B" class.

After the close of entries a dog may be moved down in their class level (i.e., Master to Excellent). The request for the move to the class for which the dog is eligible must be in writing and submitted to the superintendent or trial secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of the trial.

ROUTES TO THE TRIAL

FROM THE NORTH and SOUTH: I-25 to Colorado Hwy 119 (Exit 240). Proceed west on Hwy 119, approximately 7.5 miles. Turn right on Nelson Rd. Go approximately 4/10 mile to first fairgrounds entry on right, into the fairgrounds.

RV UPDATE: Reservations are no longer taken. There are plenty of sites available. Restrooms/showers are closed for the season. All sites have electric only and camping fee includes access to the dump station. Due to the winter season, water is turned off at all sites. The cost per night is \$20, payable at the Pay Station located in front of the Campgrounds Office. You can pay with exact cash or credit card only as the Pat Station does not give out change. The Campground Host works Tuesday-Saturday, 9am-3:30pm and can be reached at 303-682-6762 if you have any questions.

You are **REQUIRED** to clean up after your dog at all of these motels. All dogs should be aired on lead. **DO NOT** leave dogs unattended inside motel rooms. Please crate your dogs while in motel rooms. The future for using these motels for all Dog Sports is in your hands. **PLEASE** do not damage any motel rooms or their surrounding areas. Your cooperation will ensure the future availability of the area motels. GDACSC does not guarantee availability at these motels.

REGARDING THE TRIAL and AKC MEASUREMENTS...

All exhibitors must check in before judging of your first class on the first day you are entered. All dogs competing in agility must have a valid AKC Official Jump Height Card or form. If the dog does not have a valid Jump Height Card or form it must be measured by a VMO, AKC Field Representative or by the judge(s) of record before it runs. Judge David Nauer will be the VMO available on Sunday. No VMO will be in attendance on Saturday. Dogs not required for further judging will be excused. Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring when it is their turn to run. Judges are not required to wait for dogs. They will adhere, as closely as possible, to the judging schedule. The owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when it is to be judged. The trial giving club and the trial secretary have no obligation or responsibility for providing service, through a public address system, or stewards, or runners, for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are to be at ring side when required.

A warm-up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump, shall be provided for all exhibitors.

A warm-up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump, shall be provided for all exhibitors.

AFTER CLOSING WAIT LIST

After the closing date, GDACSC is offering a Wait List to fill openings created by withdrawn entries after closing. A maximum of 25 entries will be placed on the wait list. All entries including wait listed entries must be received by the Trial Secretary prior to November 30, 2018 6PM. Any entries withdrawn prior to December 9, 2018 at 5 PM, will be replaced by a wait list entry when available, a full refund will be given to withdrawn entries when wait listed entries are available to replace the pulled entry. Any wait list entry that does not move off the wait list into the trial by December 9, 2018, 5 PM will receive a full refund. If a dog is pulled but cannot be replaced, the exhibitor will not receive a refund and the dog will be considered absent for the trials.
