**General Exhibitors allowed into the building at 8:00 AM**

The show site is indoors on turf. Please bring your own crate, mat, clean up supplies, & water for your dog. Dogs must be kept on leash when not in the ring or using the warm-up jump.

**TRIAL SITE RULES**

Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s). Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Trial Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement. Show Site Committee reserves the right to alter crating arrangements for space, safety or site requirements. Seating is allowed on the floor. Exhibitors are responsible for the conditions in and around their space. No dogs will be permitted to stay overnight in the arena. X-pens allowed.

**ROUTES TO THE TRIAL**

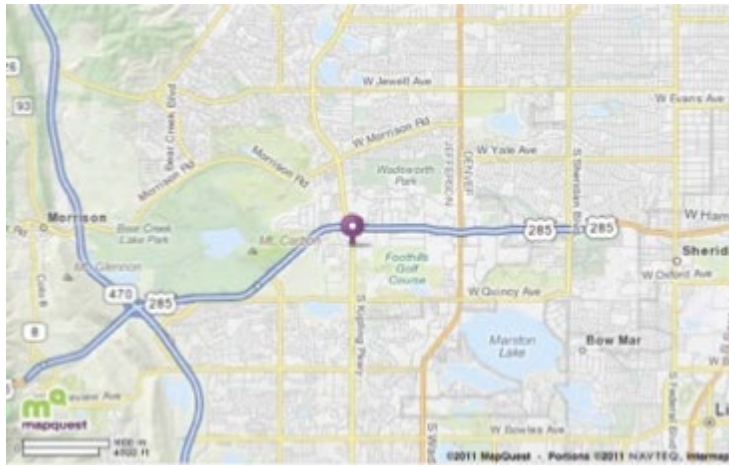
Directions to the Trial Site:

## COVID PRECAUTIONS:

- Because of the prevalence of the Delta variant and increased number of competitors traveling in from surrounding states, we have implemented new COVID-19 policies. These policies follow UKI's example set forth for the upcoming US Open.
- Masks are required for all individuals, no matter the vaccination status during all walkthroughs & when indoors and unable to safely social distance.
  - You may show proof of vaccination or a negative COVID test and run without a mask and be indoors without a mask when social distancing is possible. You will receive a wristband upon check-in if you provide one of the following:
  - You may send in a photo of your vaccination card to [lookoutats@hotmail.com](mailto:lookoutats@hotmail.com) ahead of the trial
  - You can show your vaccination card or photo of it at the trial upon check-in
  - A negative COVID test must be completed within 72 hours of October 23rd. You may email or show proof of the negative test upon check-in
- If you do not show one of the above options, you will be required to wear a mask at all times

- Absolutely no one is allowed in the building before the trial manager (Caitlin Ascher). Caitlin will open the doors at 7 am promptly. If you are found in the building before her, you will receive the bill for the building rental for the hour we are charged due to your early entry.

### UKI TRIAL INFORMATION YOU MAY FIND HELPFUL....

#### Measuring

All dogs not jumping full height must be measured by a judge or approved UKI measurer to determine the dog's jump height. To receive a permanent jump height measurement, dogs must either be competing at 24 or 22 inch jump height (20 inch Select Option) or must be two years of age for their permanent measurement. Dogs will be measured using official measuring devices while the dog is placed in a standing position on a flat surface such as a table. The measurement is taken from the perpendicular line from the top of the dog's withers to the flat surface. At the time of measuring, the measurement will be recorded and sent to the UKI office. If the dog is age two or over, the dog will only need one measurement. If there is controversy over a dog's measurement then an appointed UKI official shall re-measure the dog's height, which will be the determining measurement.

If a handler has an actual written measure from another organization and presents that card to the measurer that day, UKI will grandfather and accept that as the measure for the dog provided that measure is not within 1/8 inch (3mm) of a UKI jump height cutoff.

#### Course Walk Throughs

It is the competitor's responsibility to be aware of what is happening in the rings and be ready for your course walk throughs. We have split tournaments into groups and each competitors, regardless of their height will walk and run with their group. All Novice & Beginner classes will walk and run together.

Call Sheets: Each class will have call sheets located at the ring. Please check in for your class by ticking your name only when you have walked the course.

#### Running

It is the competitor's responsibility to know what is going on in the rings. When your jump height is running in your class you must be ready to run. This is the largest UKI event we have held in CO, we will work with you to make time for your run if you have conflicts.

#### MOVING UP

Beginners to Novice – Equivalent of 3 clear rounds (12 points, 8 from agility)

Novice to Senior – Equivalent of 5 clear rounds (20 points, 12 from agility, 4 from jumping, 4 from games)

Senior to Champ – Equivalent of 9 clear rounds (36 points, 12 from agility, 12 from jumping, 12 from games)

UKI does next day move ups!

If you gain enough points on at a trial, you must move up to the next level on the next day or trial. If it is the second day of a trial, please see the trial secretary to fill out a move up form. You will then need to fill in your scribe sheets for the new level for the classes you are entered in for that next day.

#### TRAINING ROUNDS – NOT FOR COMPETITION (NFC)

**For Pentathlon:** A no show in any of the classes or if any of the classes are run for NFC - will result in a loss of eligibility to move onto to the Final, regardless of ranking in the other classes. You will still be able to participate in the Speedstakes Consultation Run.

**Other Classes:** You may opt to make any run you have signed up for a "NFC" training Round for which you may bring in a non-audible toy into the ring. You may not use any food or clickers! You must state NFC prior to entering the ring. The Scribe will write NFC across your scribe ticket, and notify the judge. You will be given the course time to do what you wish. Listen out for the timer to yell "Time!" – You must immediately exit the ring – please stop the finish timing if electronic timing is used.

If you do not notify the judge and scribe ahead of time that you are doing NFC, you will not be able to not turn your run into a training round if you are faulted on course. Repeating any piece of equipment more than one time (Fix and Go) will be deemed training and the judge will ask you to leave the ring immediately if you do this.

#### Conflicts

If you have a conflict you must put a C beside your name to indicate this. We will make every effort to work you in prior to the class being closed out. If you do not pre check in, the class will close without you being able to run. So be sure to check in when you walk through!!!!

#### Results

If you think there is a problem, you will need to speak to the judge before he or she forgets your run. The judges' decision is final, so if you wait and the judge cannot remember your run, the scribe sheet will stand. Please remember that if the judge disagrees with you once you have stated your case, you must be a good sport and remember that the judge is only human and judging is still subjective. You will win some and you will lose some, but again the judges' decision is final.

Once all the heights within a class are finished, the results will be submitted to the show secretary by either downloading from computer scoring. The results will then be available for viewing by all competitors.
