TRIAL AND SITE HOURS:

Trial site hours: 7:00 a.m. MT – 30 min after the conclusion of judging, daily Judging to begin not earlier than 8:30 a.m. on Friday and 8:00 a.m. on Saturday & Not earlier than 7:30 a.m. Sunday. *7:00-8:00AM FRIDAY IS ONLY FOR TRIAL SET UP COMMITTEE. SIGN UP TO HELP WITH SET-UP ON THIS WORKER SHEET. Set-Up Crew will be allowed to set up their crates & mats at 7:45. If you are not on the set-up Committee, you are not allowed in the building until 8:00 am.

General Exhibitors allowed into the building at 8:00 AM

The show site is indoors on turf. Please bring your own crate, mat, clean up supplies, & water for your dog. Dogs must be kept on leash when not in the ring or using the warm-up jump.

TRIAL SITE RULES

Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s). Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Trial Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement. Show Site Committee reserves the right to alter crating arrangements for space, safety or site requirements. Seating is allowed on the floor. Exhibitors are responsible for the conditions in and around their space. No dogs will be permitted to stay overnight in the arena. X-pens allowed.

IMPORTANT

• Absolutely no one is allowed in the building before the trial chairman. The Chairman will open the doors at 7 am promptly. If you are found in the building before her, you will receive the bill for the building rental for the hour we are charged due to your early entry.

WAIT LIST FOR WITHDRAWN ENTRIES

After the closing date, MHACB is offering a Wait List to fill openings created by withdrawn entries after closing. A maximum of 20 dogs per day will be placed on the wait list. All entries, including wait listed entries, must be received by the Trial Secretary prior to Wednesday, April 3, 2024 8:00 p.m. Any entries withdrawn prior to SUNDAY, April 14, 2024 at 5 p.m., will be replaced by a wait list entry when available. A full refund will be given to withdrawn entries when wait listed entries are available to replace the pulled entry. Any wait list entry that does not move off the wait list into the trial by April 14, 2024, 5 p.m. will receive a full refund. There are waitlisted dogs each of this event. THERE ARE WAIT LISTED EACH DAY OF THE EVENT.

REGARDING AKC MEASUREMENTS and CHECKING IN and MAPS...

All exhibitors must check in before judging of your first class on each day you are entered. All dogs competing in agility must have a valid AKC Official Jump Height Card or form. There will be VMOs present at this trial.

Classes will be judged in the following order. Breaks may be called at the judge's discretion. Preliminary running order contingent on move-up entries not yet received and wait listed entry changes after the closing. (**Judges reserve the right to reorganize the schedule below to accommodate the needs of the trial**) "B" class dogs will run prior to "A" class dogs in the Novice classes, within height classifications, except where indicated otherwise. A warm-up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump, shall be provided for all exhibitors.
