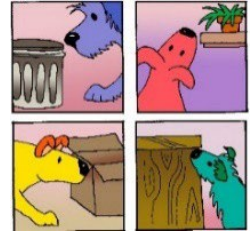

Directions:

From the North: From I70 take E470 south to the Quincy Ave Exit. Turn left and go 2 miles to the Fairgrounds entrance on your right. E470 is a Toll Road. If you don't want to take the Toll Road, get off I70 at the E470 turnoff, and watch for signs to Gun Club Road. You will turn left at E 6th Ave before the Toll Road begins. It will dead end at Gun Club Road. Turn left on Gun Club Road to Quincy Ave.

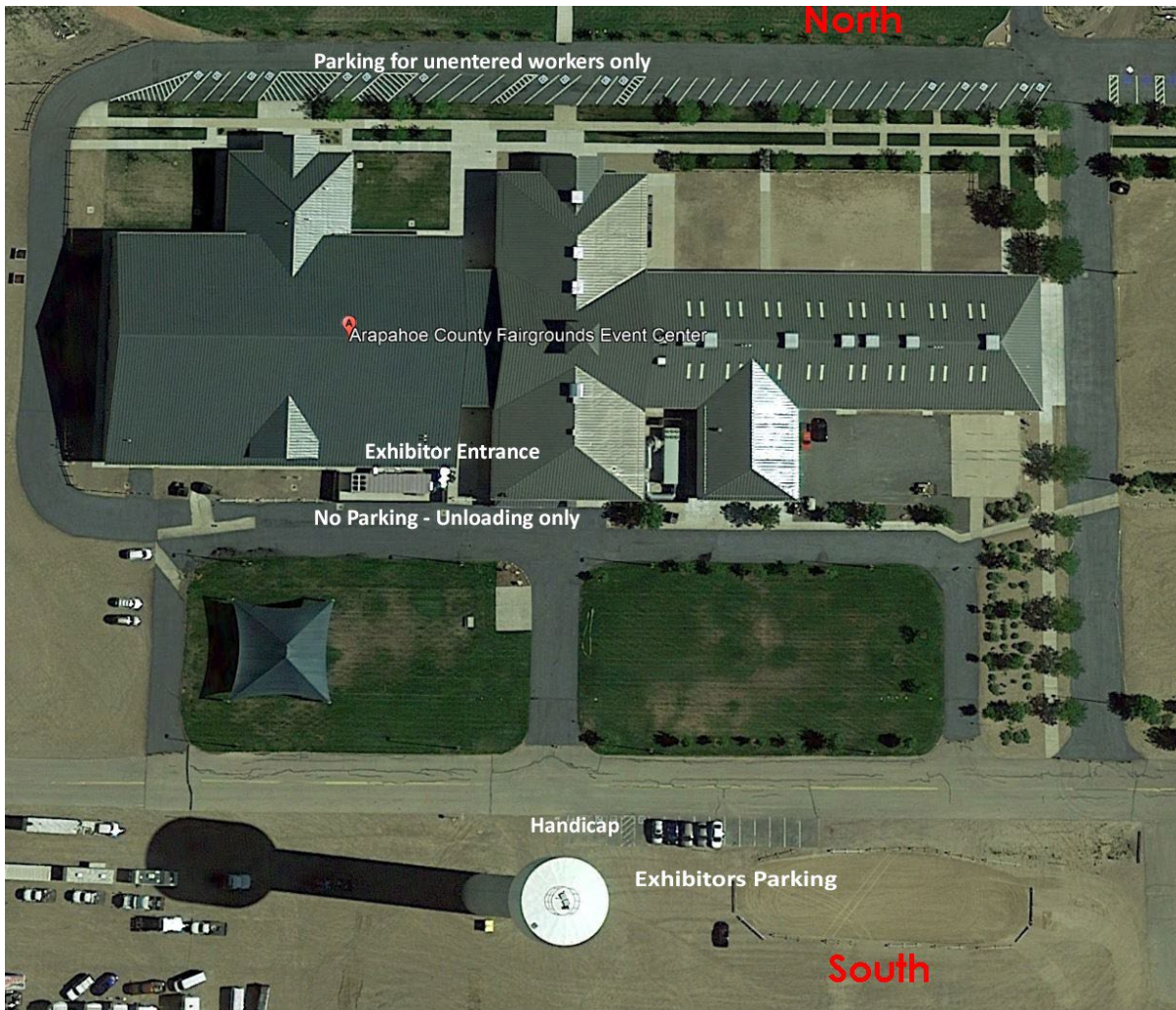
From the South: From I25 or Parker Rd. take E470 northeast to Quincy Ave Exit. Turn right and go 2 miles to the Fairgrounds entrance.

Crating: Indoor, climate-controlled crating space will be available. There are no chairs provided in the crating area – bring your own. Metal crates and Ex-Pens must have pads under them to avoid scratching the floor. Crates may be left overnight. Mountain States Dog Training Club and Arapahoe County will not be responsible for any lost or damaged items left at the show site. The facility will be locked at night.

Parking: The Exhibitor entrance and Exhibitor parking is located on the South Side of the Building. Parking on the North side is limited to unentered workers only. There will be designated Handicap Parking Spots on the blacktop on the South side of the building. Please pay attention to the signs for parking.



Dog Potty Areas: Potty areas will be designated on the South side of the facility. DO NOT ALLOW your dog to urinate on the sidewalks, building, cement poles, trash cans or any equipment. Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s). Cleaning supplies and disposal sites will be available at various locations in the designated potty areas. Please dispose of bagged poop in the outside trash cans or designated receptacles. No poop is to be disposed of inside the Event Center.

DO NOT take your dog out to the North side of the building to potty. On your way to or from a search area on the North side of the building, please do not allow your dog to potty between the sidewalk and the building, or around the pavilion. Any of these areas may be used for Exterior search areas.

Food: Lunch will be provided for all day workers. There is no onsite concession for exhibitor food.

You may bring food into the Crating Area. There is a Taco Bell 3 miles east of the Fairgrounds on Quincy Road. There are numerous fast food and sit-down restaurants at Southlands Shopping Center about 4 miles south of the Fairgrounds on Gun Club Road.

Water: Arapahoe County Fairgrounds has installed water bottle filling stations. Bring your refillable water bottle.

Ribbons: Qualifying, Placement and New Title Ribbons distribution will be self-serve from the Awards Table

Running Order: If possible, dogs are to be run in the order posted. Volunteers will run first in each class. If there is a conflict between classes, mark the check-in sheet at the Gate with a "C" by your name. If your conflict involves Handler Discrimination, please run Handler Discrimination first. If you have a conflict with another class, other than HD, please run first in the class that has the least number of exhibitors remaining to run to minimize delays in closing out classes. Once you are ready to run in the conflicting class, notify the Gate Steward that you are available so they can insert you back into the running order.

You are responsible for knowing when it is your turn to run and being ready to go. If you are not ready to move to the search area when your number is called, the next available exhibitor will be called. Gate Stewards will not wait for - or go looking for exhibitors. When you become available, the steward will insert you into the running order as appropriate. It may be at the end of the class.

Move Ups: The request for a Move-up or a lateral transfer must be in writing and presented to the trial secretary at least 30 minutes (6:30 AM day of trial) prior to the start of each trial. Transfers may be approved provided the class is available and the judge has not reached her limit.

Withdrawal from Trial - Wait List: There is a Wait List for both trials at the time of closing. On the day of the trial, the club may assign entries for absent individuals to those on the wait list who are present at the trial site. If multiple waitlisted individuals are present at the event site, the runs must be assigned in wait-list order.
