Judging Program and Trial Information
Douglas County Fair Grounds
Castle Rock , CO**

MHGRC is very excited to host our third AKC Scent Work Trial at Douglas County Fair Grounds. The Club has been working very hard to provide a great experience for first time exhibitors as well as the experienced dog/handler teams. We have two great experienced judges, Ruth Ann Stricker and Jean Hilbig. If you have any questions, please ask. Welcome and safe travel to our trial!

Trial Hours: 7 a.m to 7:00pm each day- Please do not arrive prior to 7 am. To help you determine arrival, on Saturday all novice elements will be completed, then all advanced, then all excellent and then all master elements. On Sunday we are starting with all Master elements, then Excellent, then Advanced and ending with all Novice elements. Self Check in will be open from 7 -2:30 both days. There is plenty of parking and ample crating space. You are welcome to arrive and check in when convenient but when the judges are ready, the class/element will start and we cannot hold up judging for a missing exhibitor. It's a full day .

Covid-Mile Hi Golden Retriever Club will follow the most current governmental and facility regulations in place at the time of the trials. Please respect everyone's space, especially if they are wearing a mask and you are not. It will be up to each judge to decide if they want exhibitors to wear a mask while searching in their classes. Please respect the decision of the judges in this matter. If you are ill, feel unwell, are coughing, sneezing or running a temperature, please stay home.

Directions:

From the south: From I 25 take exit 181 Plum Creek Pkwy/Frontage Rd toward Wilcox St. At the end of the ramp turn right onto Plum Creek Pkwy and continue through the lights and at the top of the hill at the second set of lights turn left onto Fairgrounds Rd. Drive to the west end of the grounds to the large Horse Barn parking area.

From the north: From I 25 take exit 181 Plum Creek Pkwy/Frontage Rd toward Wilcox St. At the end of the ramp turn left onto Plum Creek Pkwy and continue through the lights and at the top of the hill at the second set of lights turn left onto Fairgrounds Rd. Drive to the west end of the grounds to the large Horse Barn parking area.

Schedule both days:

7am – 2:30 Competitor Check-in throughout the day

Handlers' briefing and walk thrus will be immediately before the start of each class (Novice, Advanced, Excellent, Masters) and judging will follow immediately after briefings and walk thrus

Lunch breaks will be taken as determined by the judges

Crating space: East end of the large Horse Barn has concrete floors and ample space. You may use any of the cleaned stalls in the general crating area, but please clean up after your usage of the stall.

Parking: You may park anywhere in the parking lot adjacent to the large Horse barn. Due to search areas set up in the barn, enter only thru the East end of the building where you may crate and check in.

Potty Area: Please potty your dogs on the west side of the parking lot and avoid line of sight for exterior search areas on the East end of the building. There is a grassy area next to the parking lot.

Day of Trial Entries: There will be no day of trial entries. Wait listed exhibitors present will be able to take any "absent" entry spots.

Food: Lunch will be provided for all day volunteers. **Food Vendors** will not be available on-site. Fast food and restaurants are located within 5 miles, including Taco Bell, McDonalds, Jack in the Box, Subway, Wendy's, Burger King, Chick-fil-A, Sonic, Jimmy Johns, Arby's, Panda Express, Smash Burger, Panera's, Jersey Mikes Subs

Ribbons: Qualifying, Placement and New Title Ribbons distribution will be self-serve from the Awards Table.

Move Ups: Next day move-ups are being offered. AKC requires move-ups to be in writing to the trial secretary, no later than 30 minutes after the end of Saturday's trial.

Running Order:

As previously stated, all elements of each class will be completed before starting the next class. Because there will be 2 searches running concurrently in the same class, one element will run in numerical order top to bottom and the other will start half way down to the end and start back at the top to avoid conflicts. If you have dogs in different classes, there should be no conflicts, so please be ready when your number is coming up to avoid delays. If you are still concerned about a conflict, please place a "C" by your dog during check in.
