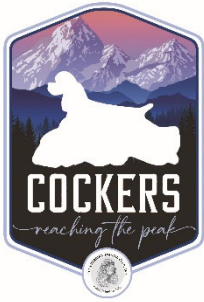

ENTRY METHOD

First Received with preference for Cocker Spaniels. All entries will be accepted on the opening date, but only entries for Cocker Spaniels will be entered into the trial for the first 3 weeks. All other entries will be put on a waiting list. At 8 am MTN Time Zone on May 29, 2024, those entries will be entered in the trial in the order received until the trial limits are reached. Entries received on or after 8 am MTN Time Zone on May 29 will be entered in the trial in order of receipt regardless of breed until the trial limits are reached.

YOU CAN NOW ENTER VIA AKC's ONLINE ENTRY SERVICES

Go to the AKC Agility Online Entry Services home page at www.akc.org/AgilityEntry and follow the instructions there to use your My AKC account to enter this event online. During the first 48 hours after opening, the initial limit of entries designated as either online or paper will be as follows: 150 online entries and 200 paper entries each day. If either form of entry (paper or online) has not filled at the end of the 48 hour time period, the club reserves the right to decrease or increase either one accordingly.

E-mail preliminary and final confirmations will be sent to those listing a legible e-mail address on the entry form. PLEASE WRITE LEGIBLY.

OBSTACLES

Obstacles will meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of the Regulations for Agility Trials. All classes will take place indoors on a dirt surface. This trial will be held indoors, in two dirt rings, run concurrently.

COURSE FAMILIARIZATION & TIMING

Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, during a walk-through period held prior to the start of the class. The walk-through is restricted to handlers entered in that class only. Handlers with multiple dogs, at events with multiple rings may request to walk with a height group other than the one their dog is entered in if a conflict is imminent. A warm-up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump, may be provided for exhibitors. The warm-up area is to be used exclusively for warming up the dog and not for training or relieving of the dog. Umbrellas are not allowed on the course during the walk thru.

Electronic timing devices may be used.

Please consult the AKC Regulations for Agility Trials for a complete description and eligibility for entry into these classes. The exhibitor is fully responsible for entering the dog in the correct class(es)/height divisions. Dogs running in a lower height division than they are eligible for will be eliminated.

AFTER CLOSING DATE WAIT LIST

After the closing date, ASC is offering a Wait List to fill openings created by withdrawn entries after closing. A maximum of 25 dogs per day will be placed on the wait list. All entries, including wait listed entries, must be received by the Trial Secretary prior to Wednesday, July 10, 2024 12:00 p.m.. Any entries withdrawn prior to SUNDAY, July 22, 2024 at 5PM, will be replaced by a wait list entry when available. A full refund will be given to withdrawn entries when wait listed entries are available to replace the pulled entry. Any wait list entry that does not move off the wait list into the trial by July 22, 2024, 5PM will receive a full refund.

HEIGHT DIVISIONS

Effective January 1, 2010, exhibitors are no longer required to provide proof to Trial Secretaries that their dog has a valid jump height card as part of the check-in process. Furthermore, this change eliminates the need for a copy of the jump height card to be submitted with an entry form. Dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form may still compete; but they must be measured/wicketed by the **Judge of Record** PRIOR to running in their class and this measurement will be valid for that weekend of trials only. The exception to this requirement is a dog entered in the 24" or 26" height division. However, if a **Volunteer Measuring Official (VMO)** or an **Agility Field Rep** is present; **ALL** dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form must be measured at some time during the trial or cluster of trials. This does not preclude having the dog wicketed by the Judge of Record if the VMO or Rep is not available to measure the dog **before** its first run of the trial or cluster of trials. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured prior to running and failure to do so will result in the cancellation of any qualifying scores.

Entering a Mixture of Regular and Preferred Classes Within the Same Trial Weekend

– Multiple Jump Heights Within the Same Trial Day

Exhibitors may enter a mixture of both Regular and Preferred classes on the same trial day and/or during a trial weekend. Any mixture of Regular and Preferred classes is allowed. Please note that if a dog qualifies in Regular Master Standard and Preferred Master JWW (or vice versa) on the same trial day, then NO Double Q shall be earned toward either the MACH or PACH title. The Double Q still requires that Standard Agility and Jumpers With Weaves be either both Regular OR both Preferred on the same trial day.

Additionally, within the same Regular or Preferred classes, a dog may now be entered in multiple jump heights within the same trial day. For example, the same dog may now be entered in 20-inch Master STD/JWW while also entered in 24-inch Premier STD/JWW on the same trial day.

A separate entry form must be submitted when the same dog is being entered in a mixture of Regular and Preferred and/or different jump heights within the same trial weekend thereby clearly indicating which class(es) and/or jump heights belong together for each trial day of the weekend.

Fix and Go On (FNG)

FNG allows exhibitors to immediately reattempt an obstacle at any time while on course when the dog's performance of an obstacle is not to their expectation. This allows the dog to successfully complete the obstacle then finish the course or leave the ring on a positive note. Using FNG will result in a non-qualifying score. Fix and Go On is not pre-entered; rather, it occurs during the course of the run. (offered)

ENTERING FOR EXHIBITION ONLY (FEO)

(Offered)

- FEO runs are treated as trial entries. FEO does not need to be noted on the entry form; the handler will declare the day of the show.
- Dogs may be entered in any jump height for FEO runs. If entered in an ineligible jump height, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show jump height changes are not allowed.
- FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show level changes are not allowed.
- The exhibitor must declare FEO in the ring prior to leading out. FEO may be declared earlier (ex. when checking in at the gate board).
- Toys are allowed in the ring
- o Toys must be non-audible
- o Toys may not leave the handler's hand
- o Toys that roll freely cannot be used
- Food/treats are not allowed in the ring
- FEO should be utilized for the benefit of the dog and not as a punitive correction. Harsh verbal and/or physical corrections shall not be tolerated. Any determination of harshness by the judge shall be immediately whistled and the handler will be dismissed from the ring.
- A judge must monitor the entire run. Judges can stop a run at any time

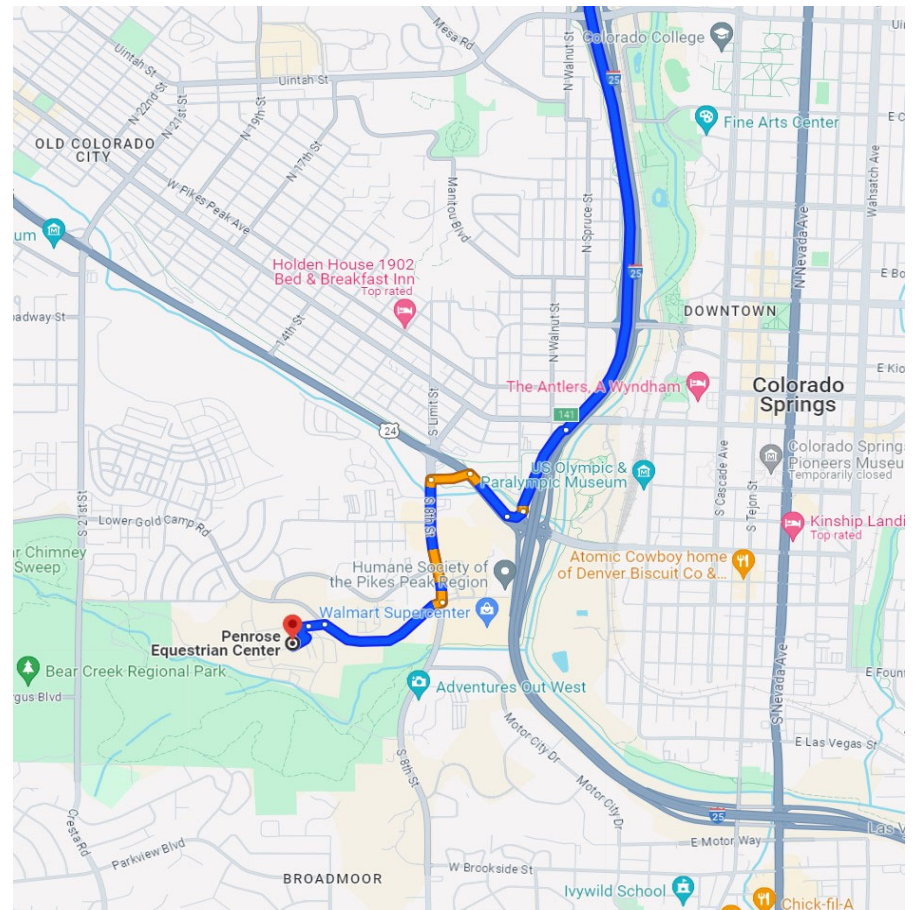

AWARDS

All days

Rosettes will be awarded to First Place through Fourth Place in each jump height in each class. Qualifying rosettes will be awarded to all dogs receiving a qualifying score. Dogs must qualify to receive placement rosettes. Rosettes will be awarded in each jump height division in each class as follows:

First Place	Blue
Second Place	Red
Third Place	Yellow
Fourth Place	White

A green qualifying ribbon will be given to all qualifying dogs.

Dogs must receive a qualifying score to receive placement award

Dogs earning an AGCH, MACH or PACH will receive a commemorative rosette and bar. If both a PACH and PAX are earned, only one rosette will be presented. Dogs earning a new title will receive a New Title ribbon or rosette. Dogs earning a qualifying score in Master Standard and Master JWW in the same trial (does not include Premier classes) will receive a Double Qualifying ribbon

Additional Special Breed Agility Awards *(days noted are days to be entered for each award)*

AJ Award (Thursday)

This award is offered by Olga K. Evelyn (Amunique) and Rosemary A. Collins (RoCol) in memory of AMUNIQUE'S SIR AJ DONOHUE LOUIS. A plaque displaying the likeness of the original AJ Trophy, an attached frame for the winner's photo, and \$200 will be awarded to the cocker who accumulates the highest number of championship points (MACH) on the Cocker Only Day(s) of the agility trial held at the ASC Cocker Spaniel National. Qualifying points from the Standard and/or Jumpers Master Classes will accumulate towards championship points (MACH). The winning cocker will also receive a neck ribbon provided through the agility general donation of ASC supporters.

The Bailey Award of Agility Excellence (Thursday - Sunday)

This award is offered by Vivian Hudson (Bar-Bax Cockers) in memory of Bailey (MACH16 Bar-Bax's Makin' New Waves, CD, MXB5, MJS5). A crystal trophy, rosette and \$100 will be awarded to a Cocker Spaniel 7 years or older showing in both Master Standard and JWW classes (Preferred cockers are not eligible) who accumulates the most points during the total days of the ASC Cocker Spaniel National agility trials. Points are accumulated by calculating each MACH point earned (points under course time) and 10 points per Double Qualifying score per day. This award is to acknowledge consistency, speed and stamina of an older Cocker Spaniel who is showing and performing well in the Master level classes at their regular jump height.

The Brookie Preferred Award (Thursday)

This award is offered by Vivian Hudson (Bar-Bax Cockers) in memory of Brookie (MACH10 PACH Anastasia My Satilla Bar-Bax, MXS4, MJS5, MXP4, MXPB, MJP3, MJPB, Pax). A crystal trophy and rosette will be awarded to a cocker who is 9 years or older that accumulates the highest number of PACH points on the Cocker Only Day of the agility trial held at the ASC Cocker Spaniel National. Qualifying points from the Preferred Standard and Jumpers Master Classes will accumulate towards points.

The CCCC Award (Thursday - Saturday)

This award is offered by the Capital City Cocker Club to Cocker Spaniels under the age of 7 showing at the Masters level in Standard, Jumpers and Premier over the first three days of the ASC Cocker Spaniel National agility trial. This award encompasses all the aspects of agility; speed, consistency and handling. The winning score will be calculated based on MACH points earned in each regular class, plus 5 additional points for a double qualifying score. Premier points will be calculated in the same fashion, but with 10 additional points awarded for a qualifying score in both Standard and Jumpers. Cocker in both regular and preferred classes are eligible, but the Preferred competitors will be scored using the same course time as the regular classes. The winning Cocker and handler will receive a statue trophy with an engraved plaque.

The Star Premier Award (Thursday - Saturday)

This award is offered by Sylvia Martinez in honor of Star (MACH2 St. James Bright Star Angel, MXC, MJC, MXP, MJP2, MXF, T2B3). A trophy will be awarded to the cocker who is entered in all Premier classes (regular or preferred) during the 4 days of the ASC Cocker Spaniel National and has the fastest accumulated times from qualifying scores. The award will be calculated on a weighted basis using yards per seconds and a weighted factor when comparing Regular and Preferred.

EXHIBITOR INFORMATION

SAFETY, BEHAVIOR and LIABILITY

The safety of the dog is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely. It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. The AMERICAN SPANIEL CLUB, INC and its agents, employees, etc., will assume no responsibilities for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children. The AMERICAN SPANIEL CLUB, INC reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression. No one shall have any recourse or claim against the AMERICAN SPANIEL CLUB, INC or any official thereof.

All dogs must be on leash at all times when on trial grounds except when in the designated warm-up area or competing on the course.

All regulations governing the use of this facility, and all regulations and decisions of the Event Committee at this trial will be strictly enforced, including and not limited to the recorded information of this premium list.

Puppies under 4 months of age are prohibited at AKC Agility Trials.

This club does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the Official AKC entry form for this event.

ENTRY ELIGIBILITY

Breeds Eligible: All AKC-Recognized Breeds

This trial is open to all dogs 15 months and older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or have obtained an AKC ILP/PAL number. Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind shall not be eligible, and neither are bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate.

Dogs with a Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number (in trials allowing mixed breed entries) must be spayed or neutered in order to compete. Wherever the word "dog" is used in these regulations it includes both sexes.

REFUNDS

No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. No entry fee will be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of the Event Committee.

No refunds for overpayment of \$10.00 or less.

Change of judge, after the distribution of the premium list, if the judging assignment changes, an exhibitor has the right to request a full refund of their entry fees for any class affected. Exhibitors must submit requests in writing to the Trial Secretary a minimum of 30 minutes preceding the start of the event on the first day the exhibitor is entered.

Bitches in season are not permitted to compete in AKC Agility Trials. The Club will issue a refund for the trial entries, less a \$10.00/ entered day processing fee.

Chapter 1, Section 9 of the Regulations for Agility Trials, <http://images.akc.org/pdf/rulebooks/REAGIL.pdf>, states, "Females in season must be fully refunded if withdrawn by the Trial Secretary after closing and no later than one half hour prior to the start of the first class of the day of the trial. The club may retain a processing fee and must publish this information in the premium (no fee is paid to the American Kennel Club for females in season who are withdrawn)."

RINGSIDE

Dogs may arrive any time prior to judging. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running. All dogs not needed for further judging will be excused.

Judges are not required to wait for dogs. The Owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when it is to be judged. The Club has no responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required. Food will be available for purchase.

CRATING and SEATING

Crating will be provided between the Agility Ring and the Obedience and Rally Extension Rings. Please bring your own chairs. The Event Committee reserves the right to regulate and rearrange crating arrangements.

PARKING

Exhibitors are governed by any rules or regulations of civil authorities and building and parking regulations. Vehicles parked contrary to regulations will be subject to towing at owner's expense.

PLEASE NOTE: A limited number of handicap spaces are available. They will be available on a first-come basis. A valid handicap plate must be on each vehicle using these spaces. Parking in front of building is limited to those with handicapped permits and unloading only. THESE SPACES WILL NOT ACCOMMODATE MOTOR HOMES.

Club officials may require that vehicles or equipment be rearranged to accommodate additional vehicles. Area around vehicles MUST be kept clean at all times. All vehicles will be parked at owner's risk. El Paso County Fairgrounds and AMERICAN SPANIEL CLUB, INC will not be responsible for loss by burglary, fire, or any other cause whatsoever to the vehicle or its contents.

From Chapter 1, Section 20: Move-Up entries will be accepted for dogs that have completed a title after the closing date. Email notification of move up or class change is acceptable, with return receipt verification from the secretary. Either Move Up forms or emails must be completed and delivered to the Trial Secretary prior to 6 PM, the Monday prior to the trial. Move-up entries for Saturday or Sunday must be delivered to the Trial Secretary within 30 minutes of the conclusion of judging of the class they are moving up from. Dogs so moved up will run at the end of the running order. Move-ups can only be accepted if judging limits are not exceeded.

Entry move-up valid only if the dog was already entered in the Event indicated and only if approved by the Trial Secretary. Dogs moved up will run at the end of the class running order.

Effective February 1, 2017

Regulations for Agility Trials: Chapter 1, Section 21. Change of Entry. In addition to Move-ups as described in Chapter 1, Section 20 entries may also be changed as noted in this section. A dog which has been entered in a Novice "A" class for which it is not eligible to be entered in due to class restrictions on the dog or handler may be moved to the Novice "B" class under the following conditions:

The request for the move must be in writing and presented to the superintendent or trial secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of each trial. The request must state the reason and justification for the move from a Novice "A" class to the Novice "B" class.

After the close of entries a dog may be moved down in their class level (i.e., Master to Excellent). The request for the move to the class for which the dog is eligible must be in writing and submitted to the superintendent or trial secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of the trial.

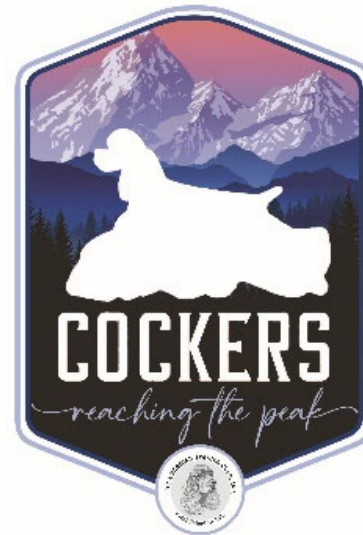
